The Associated Editors Co. (AECO) will hold the Word Cup Philippines Seminar Series on Aug. 12-14, 2016 at Angels Hills, Tagaytay City and at Girls Scouts of the Philippines Baguio City on Aug. 26-28, 2016.

The journalism seminar series aim to:

1. Become a venue for journalism students and teachers to further sharpen their writing skills;
2. Involve participants in the discussion, analysis and writing of the burning issues of the day;
3. Introduce evolving trends in newspaper page design in the Philippines;
4. Prepare students who will be participating in their upcoming individual and group contests.

The target participants of this conference are students, school paper advisers, language and communications arts teachers, department heads and school heads.

Registration Fees:

P3,500 (Tagaytay City venue for Collaborative/Radio Broadcasting)
P3,000 (early bird promo Tagaytay venue; pay until July 16, 2016)

P4,000 (Baguio City venue for individual contests)
P3,500 (early bird promo Baguio venue; pay until July 31, 2016)

Fees cover food (2 breakfast, 2 lunch, 1 dinner, 3 snacks) and one night accommodation (non-aircon) and electronic seminar materials. Day 0 (Aug. 12) is registration only. Participants from far-flung places can come on Day 0 and pay an additional 700/person for a night's accommodation. Actual seminar starts on Day 1.

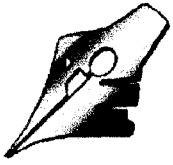

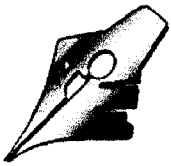
