The Summit aims to guide all stakeholders in building their capacities for the implementation of a sustainable inclusive school for students with disabilities with the goal of building a thoughtful and proactive community for inclusive education.

The Summit will cover the following topics:

1. Teaching and Leading the School with the Spirit of Shared Understanding;
2. Focusing on the Heart of School Systems—Teachers;
3. Examining the Soul of Education—Students;
4. The Power of Connection and Collaboration—Community, School, Parents in Developing and Implementing a Sustainable Inclusive Education;
5. Effective Practices that Supports Students with Disabilities;
6. Impact of Inclusion on Academic Outcomes;
7. Making Inclusion Works for Everyone;
8. Evidence of Successful Inclusive Practice in Schools;
9. Pushing the Legislative Framework that Supports Inclusive Education;
10. Curriculum Development—Transition Planning/Life Skills; and
11. The Disruptive Innovation—Special Education (SPED) to Inclusion.

The target participants are regional directors, schools division superintendents, assistant schools division superintendents, regional education program supervisors in SPED, district supervisors, principals, department heads, master teachers, preschool, elementary and secondary teachers, and SPED teachers from both public and private schools, and the academe from around the world, as well as government agencies and organizations involved in serving people with disabilities.

Participation of both public and private schools shall be subject to the *no-disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.

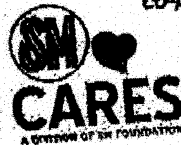

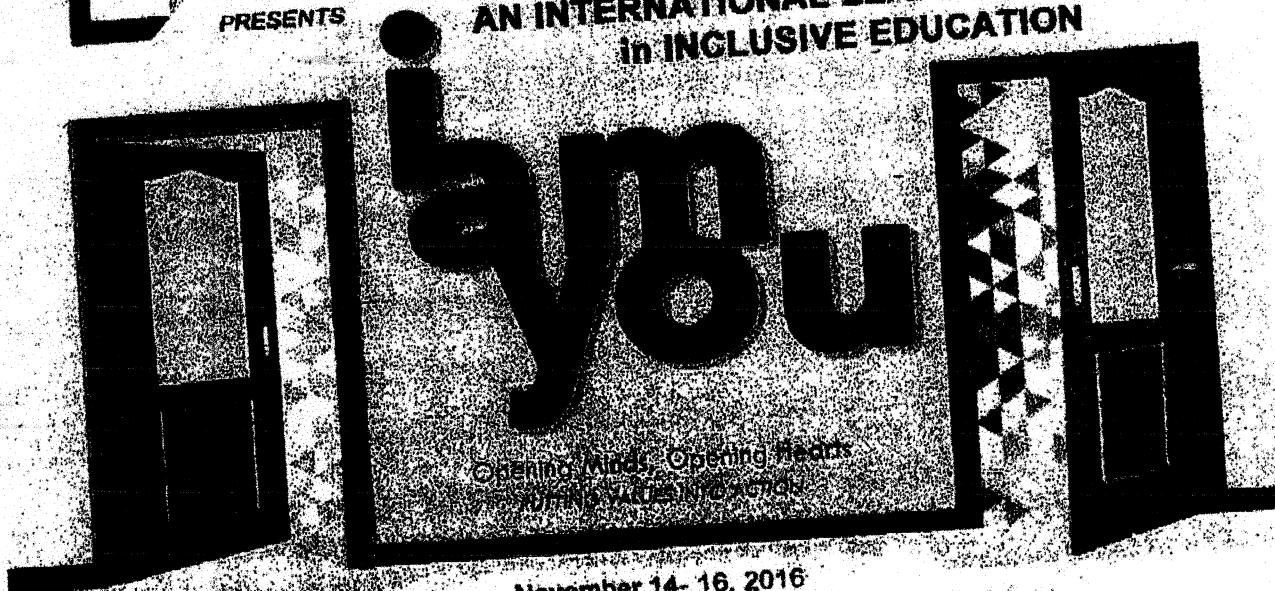
