- 6. For the other slides of the presentation, the following must be given an emphasis:
 - a. Brief introduction including the purpose and significance of the study.
 - b. Theoretical and conceptual framework
 - c. Methodology
 - d. Results and discussion
 - e. Conclusion and recommendation
 - f. Bibliography
- Each concurrent session will declare Best Abstract Paper and Best Research Paper.
 Moreover, Best Oral Presenter will be awarded which will be coming from three major criteria: Oral Presentation, Powerpoint Presentation and Attire.
