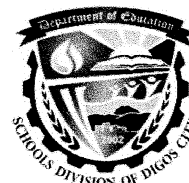

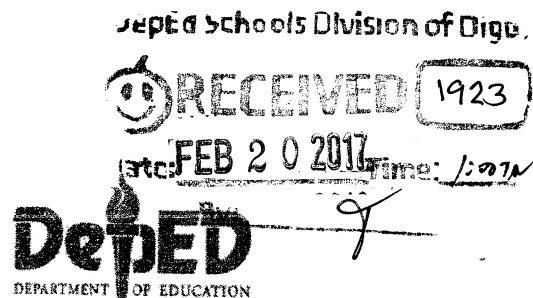



We would like to invite you and your teachers once again to the **1st International Leadership Summit and Seminar in Inclusive Education** to be held on February 22-24, 2017 this time at the SMX Convention Center.

Pasay City, PH

For the first time ever, educators, legislators, service providers, support groups/associations, international organizations, disabled people organizations, international and local students and parents will gather together at this Summit to set the cornerstone for building a thoughtful and proactive community for inclusive education. The theme of the Summit is **I am You – Opening Minds, Opening Hearts: Putting Values into Action**.

A multidisciplinary team has been formed to plan the Summit comprised of international organizations, various NGOs, disabled people organizations and the academe. A committee led by The Asia Foundation/Fully Abled Nation is currently working on a joint bill with the office of Senator Bam Aquino and Congressman Alfred Vargas that would implement public policy to genuinely serve the people with disabilities. The two legislators were invited to present the joint bill to be joined by VP President Leni Robredo, UNICEF Deputy Representative Ms. Julia Rees, and SMX Vice President Annie Garcia in opening the event.

Renowned international experts in inclusive education are expected to provide the keynotes at the Summit, namely Dr. Tony Booth from the University of Cambridge, celebrated author of the Index to Inclusion (translated into 40 languages), Dr. Els Heijnen-Maathuis, Regional Education Adviser of Save the Children, and David Hoff of the Massachusetts based Institute for Community Inclusion. We have extraordinary people to tell their overcoming-disability-to succeed success stories. Schools, both public and private, parents, and service providers have been invited to share their best practices/perspectives on how inclusion works for their children.

The Summit is co presented by The Teacher's Gallery and SMX/SM Cares and is supported in the planning by the Basic Education Sector Transformation (BEST), Unilab Project Inclusion, The Asia Foundation/Fully Abled Nation, Best Buddies, Save the Children, ATRIEV, Norfil Foundation, Center for Possibilities Foundation Inc., Leonard Cheshire Disability, CEU Inclusion Program, Reach International and UP College of Education.

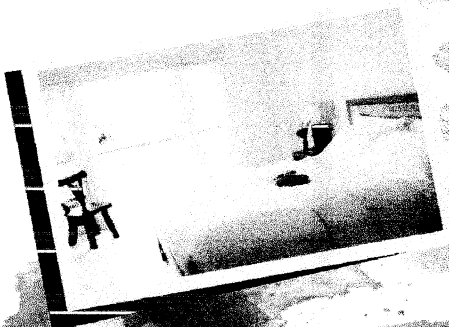

8. Evidence of Successful Inclusive Practice in Schools;
9. Pushing the Legislative Framework that Supports Inclusive Education;
10. Curriculum Development–Transition Planning/Life Skills; and
11. The Disruptive Innovation–Special Education (SPED) to Inclusion.

The target participants are regional directors, schools division superintendents, assistant schools division superintendents, regional education program supervisors in SPED, district supervisors, principals, department heads, master teachers, preschool, elementary and secondary teachers, and SPED teachers from both public and private schools, and the academe from around the world, as well as government agencies and organizations involved in serving people with disabilities.
