RATIONALE

The implementation of the K to 12 program is in full-swing with the addition of Grade 11 beginning school year 2016-17. One of the new subjects in Grade 11 is Practical Research I, a qualitative research subject. This is offered in the second semester. Based on the competencies from the Department of Education (DepEd), students are expected to manifest understanding and learned skills in qualitative research. A concrete evidence is a research output. Since research is not complete without dissemination and publication, Cor Jesu College, through the Basic Education Department and Research and Publication Office (RPO), will hold a regional research congress for senior high school students. This congress is an avenue where students from Region XI will showcase their research outputs. The nature of the conference is multi-disciplinary. Only senior high school students are allowed to participate as presenters. Junior high school students and faculty are only participants.

OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the conference are to:

- 1 disseminate research outputs of senior high school students;
- 2 share and learn the best practices from different schools in conducting qualitative research; and
- 3 recognize outstanding student-research paper presenters in Region XI.

ABOUT THE ORGANIZER

Cor Jesu College is a Catholic college offering kinder to graduate programs. The school regularly conducts institutional research congresses for both faculty and students. Several members of the faculty and administrators of the school are research practitioners with research publications in local and international journals. Submit a 200-word abstract with five parts: (1) introduction of the study; (2) purpose of the study; (3) methods; (4) results; and (5) discussion.

Also provide a keywords having four parts: (1) discipline of the study; (2) concepts investigated (topics) ; (3) methods and process (e.g. phenomenological); (4) geography (country/continent).

Send abstract to seniorhighcongress2017@gmail.com. For the authors of accepted abstracts, they will receive conference guidelines, including the criteria for the best oral presenter and best powerpoint presentation.
