3. encourage more students to join science clubs and to be involved with their teachers in the Science clubbing movement.

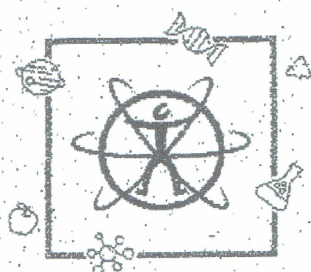
The target participants are enrolled junior high school science club members (Grades 7-10) and advisers from both public and private schools.
