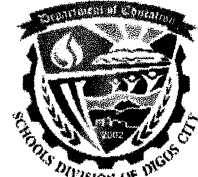

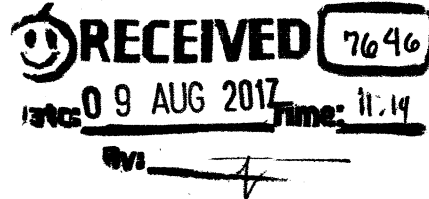

The Research and Publication Center of the University of Mindanao is organizing a two-day seminar-workshop dubbed as "**Training on the Use of Advanced Data Analysis for Decision-Making**" on August 14-15, 2017 at UM Bolton Campus, Davao City. The training will be participated both by UM and non-UM participants, particularly research course teachers, undergraduate and Professional Schools (graduate school) research advisers and mentors, statisticians, research coordinators, faculty-members and graduate students.

Three statistical classes will be discussed: (a) moderating, mediating and confounding effects to be discussed by Dr. John Stephen Curada, (b) exploratory and confirmatory factor analyses to be discussed by Dr. Felix Chavez Jr., and (c) data envelopment analysis as tool in efficiency estimation by Assoc. Prof. John Vianne Murcia.

Each participant is pegged at **two thousand five hundred pesos (Php 2,500.00)** as registration fee, to cover training/workshop fees, training kit, training certificate, software (In CD) and meals/snacks.
