Greetings from the science clubbing movement



- The Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs Inc. (PSYSC) is a national organization that supports science education through effective learning materials and interactive activities for students and teachers. It promotes Public Understanding of Science, Technology, and Environment (PUSTE).
- September has been declared as the National Science Club Month, an in pursuant with Presidential Proclamation No. 264, PSYSC together with the DOST and DepEd are enjoined to hold activities in celebration of NSCM.
- Cognizant to the significance of the youth to promote PUSTE, PSYSC announces its activities for the upcoming NSCM and aims:
  - To provide a venue for learning science, technology and environment outside the four walls of the classroom.
  - b. To foster camaradorie and develop leadership skills among the Science Clubbers

- 7. The MathsciaKa is a Luzon-based activity and will be held on September 23, 2017 in the National Capital Region.
