The Center for Social Innovation, Local Knowledge, and Educational Research (CSILKER) and the Institutional Research and Publications Office (IRPO) would like to conduct a National Seminar-Workshop on Action Research for Teachers with the theme, "Fostering a Favorable Research Culture among 21st Century Educators through Action Research" on May 16-19, 2018 at the Bulwagang Teodulfo Domingo, University of Saint Louis, Tuguegarao City, Cagayan.

The seminar-workshop is primarily designed to gather basic education and higher education teachers and undergraduate and graduate students in the Philippines. Specifically, it aims to:

- a. update the participants on the status of action research in the Basic Education and Higher Education institutions in the Philippines;
- b. provide opportunities for teachers and students to share their action researches/studies in a scholarly environment;
- c. strengthen the research capacity of teachers and students through building strong research partnerships and linkages:
- d. inculcate to the participants the value and importance of doing action research in the 21st century teaching and learning environment; and
- e. provide participants a thorough discussion on the different processes and methodologies in doing action research.

The expected participants of the said national seminar-workshop are the basic education and higher education teachers and undergraduate and graduate students both from the public and private schools in the Philippines. A minimal fee of two thousand pesos (PhP 2,000.00) will be collected from the participants which will cover 2 lunch, 4 snacks, seminar kits, certificate of participation, certificate of recognition as oral presenters, honorarium of the keynote speaker and trainers, venue rentals, and other expenses.

Furthermore, a pocket-seminar will be conducted on the first day of the seminar-workshop with a minimal fee of PhP 200.00 which will cover snacks, certificates of participation and attendance to the participants, and honorarium of the pocket seminar facilitators. The pocket-seminar will be conducted to update the participants on the current trends in education specifically along the areas of educational technology and research.

In addition, an optional Cagayan tour will be conducted on the fourth day of the said activity. A minimal fee of PhP 500.00 will be collected from the participants who opt to avail the Cagayan Tour. The fee will include transportation expenses, entrance fee of the Callao Caves, snacks, and lunch.

In line with this, we would like to ask permission from your good office for the approval of the said research undertaking. Attached are the copies of needed documents for your reference.
