

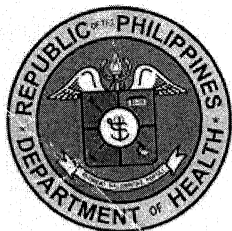

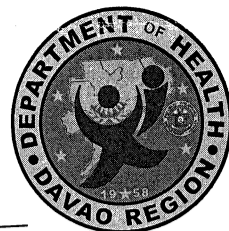

DOH in partnership with Society of Adolescent Medicine in the Philippines, Inc. (SAMPI), and UNICEF- developed the Adolescent Health Education and Practical Training (ADEPT) E-Learning Toolkit that is a step-by-step guide to field workers in the provision of care to common adolescent health and development conditions in a way that is more effective, sensitive and appropriate to adolescents' needs.

Health-care providers (HCP) have important contributions to make in promoting healthy development in adolescents and in preventing and responding to health problems in them, if and when they arise. However, situation analyses and needs assessment exercises carried out in point to shortcomings in their professional capabilities and in their "human qualities" as a result of which they are unable and sometimes unwilling to deal with adolescents in an effective and sensitive manner.

To address this need, the Department of Health Regional Office XI will be conducting series of roll-out trainings on the use of ADEPT E-learning Toolkit for service providers who deals with both in-school and out of school adolescents. The topics chosen are based on what the Adolescent and Youth Policy development indicted as behaviors that should be focused to reduce morbidity and mortality in the Philippines.

2. **School Nurse/ Guidance Counselor or AHYD Coordinator of Digos City National High School**

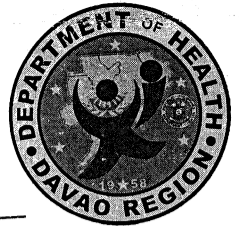
