The Philippine Folk Dance Society, (PFDS) Region XI Chapter in partnership with the Mother Association and the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) will conduct the 2019 Regional Folk Dance Workshop on September 13 – 15, 2019 at the Brokenshire Gymnasium, Madapo Hills, Davao City.

The workshop aims to:

- develop knowledge, skills, understanding and appreciation for folk and traditional dances as bridges
 of cultures and people of the Philippines and Asia;
- upgrade competencies in teaching traditional Philippine dances among teachers, dance trainers, choreographers, directors, dancers and dance enthusiasts;
- provide teachers with resource materials on dance such as dance books, music CDs, videos, handouts, among other references; and
- provide contest pieces for two (2) prestigious folk dance competitions to wit:
 (a) PFDS REGIONAL "SAYAW PINOY" Folk Dance Competition during the Araw ng Dabaw celebration.
 - (b) NCCA NATIONAL "SAYAW PINOY" Folk Dance Competition

Target participants are teachers from all levels of public and private schools, dancers, dance trainers/choreographers, members of dance groups, culture and arts personnel, p. c. majors students and cultural event coordinators.

A registration fee of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP 1,500.00) shall be charged each participant to cover workshop expenses including workshop materials, CD, t-shirt, bag, handouts, venue rental, airfare, food, accommodation and honoraria of three (3) national resource persons and staff. Part of the management expenses during the Araw ng Dabaw Folk Dance Competition will also be sourced from the registration fee.

Students can avail a 50% discount upon presentation of valid school identification. Cheque payments will not be honored.
