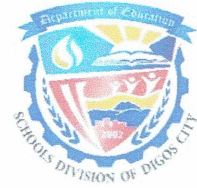

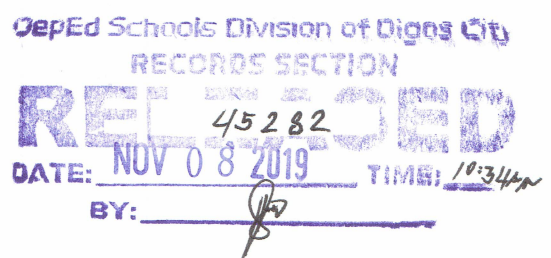

AN ORDINANCE ON TEACHERS' DAY CELEBRATION IN THE CITY OF DIGOS AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF

SECTION I. SHORT TITLE- This Ordinance shall known as "Teachers' Day Ordinance in the City of Digos".

SECTION II. DECLARATION OF POLICY- It is declared policy of this City to recognize the role of dedicated, devoted and committed teaching and non-teaching personnel of Digos City to whom the education of children depend.

SECTION III. SCOPE OF ORDINANCE- This Ordinance shall cover all teaching and non-teaching personnel whether in private schools or public schools in the City of Digos.

SECTION IV. DEFINITION OF TERMS

1. Teachers- all teaching personnel including Day Care Workers and Teachers of higher education in private or public schools in Digos City.
2. Non-Teaching Personnel- employees within academic or vocational environmental whose jobs do not involve in teaching.
3. Day Care Workers-persons primarily engaged in the provision of early child development services and program.
4. Teachers of Higher Education- leaders in the tertiary education, also called post-secondary education.
5. Public School - a school which is supported by public funds or administered by government.
6. Private School- a school which is supported and administered by a private individual rather than a government.
7. Funds- sum of money made available for a particular purpose.
8. Celebration- the action of making one's pleasure at an important event or occasion by engaging in enjoyable, typically social activity.

SECTION V. OBJECTIVES - Declaration of Digos City Teachers' Month shall have the following objectives.

A. General Objectives.

1. To motivate the teachers to do their job better as molders of the pliant minds of the youth.
2. To encourage the teachers to actively participate in all programs, projects and activities of the government.
3. To harmonize all government and non-government initiatives for the development of education sector.
4. To instill motivation for exemplary and efficient service in our teachers from both public and private schools.

B. Specific Objectives.

1. To increase spirit of volunteerism among the Teachers in Digos City particularly in the maintenance of peace and order, protection of children, preservation and conservation of environment and natural resources within the City.
2. To provide a venue for active participation of Teachers in the community in terms of cultural and eco-tourism awareness programs to be launched by this city.
3. To provide information mechanisms on Teachers in areas of education, employment, livelihood, physical and mental health and capabilities in team building and networking.
4. To broaden and strengthen the services provided by the National Government Unit concerned and private agencies to the people.

SECTION VI. - COMPONENT OF TEACHERS' DAY- Under the supervision of the Local Government Unit of Digos City, the Teachers' Day shall have the following events:

1. Creation of Teachers' Day Committees

Several committees shall be formed each year from the group of Teachers themselves and Employees from the Local Government of Digos City.

The Committee shall be composed of the following:

Chairperson: City Mayor

Vice Chairperson: Dep Ed Schools Divisions Superintendent of Digos City

Members: 1. SP Chairperson and Vice Chairperson and members of the Committee on Education, Science and Technology
2. City Social Welfare & Development Officer
3. City Local Government Operations Officer
4. SK Federation President
5. PTA Federation President
6. TEA Federation President

2. Search for Most Outstanding Teachers

There shall be a 'Search for Most Outstanding Teachers' in the City of Digos.

Four (4) categories of the "Search" shall be prepared, one outstanding Teacher will be chosen from the public elementary level and one from the private elementary level. One Outstanding Teacher shall be chosen from the public secondary school level and one Outstanding Teacher from the private schools secondary school level. One Outstanding Teacher from the Day Care Workers and one Outstanding Teacher from the Teachers on Higher Education will also be chosen.



2.1- The nomination from and criteria for judging in the "Search for Outstanding Teacher" in Digos City shall be prepared by the Committee on Awards which will be created for the purpose.

2.2- Forms and criteria shall be sent to each School Principal or Director for their nomination within the reasonable time before the presentation of winners on Teachers' Day.

2.3- The winners shall receive a Plaque of Recognition and a monetary award to be determined by the Digos City Mayor and by the Committee on Awards.

3. Giving of Monetary Awards and Plaque of Recognition to Public and Private School Teachers based on the length of service.

3.a – 45 years in service

3.b – 40 years in service

3.c – 35 years in service

3.d – 30 years in service

3.e – 25 years in service

4. There shall be various presentations of activities to be rendered by the Local Government Unit of Digos City

5. Giving of free snacks and lunch to the teaching and non-teaching personnel during National World Teachers' Day.

SECTION VII. FUNDING- For the effective implementation of this Ordinance, the Digos City Government shall appropriate an amount necessary for the success of this event subject to review and increase on an annual basis.

SECTION VIII. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE- If for any reasons, any section of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other sections which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION IX. REPEALING CLAUSE- All ordinances, rules and regulations or part thereof, in conflict with or inconsistent with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION X. APPLICABILITY CLAUSE- All other matters relating to the impositions of this ordinance shall be governed by pertinent provisions of existing laws or other ordinance.

SECTION XI. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE- This ordinance shall take effect on September 5, 2020 to October 5, 2020 and every year thereafter during National World Teachers' Day.
