



GUIDELINES AND MECHANICS

PANAGTIGIAY 2019

A. POSTER-MAKING CONTEST

Registration

- The contest only caters 25 slots to secondary schools in Region XI.
- Each participating school must notify the organizing committee its intention to participate in the contest on or before February 24, 2020 through the contact details provided in the invitation letter.
- Each participating school is entitled to be represented by a bona fide grade 9 or 10 student.
- Participants shall be in their prescribed uniform and shall wear their identification card upon registration and during the contest proper.
- Each participating school shall pay Php 100.00 registration fee. Upon registration, the students must be accompanied by one (1) official school representative delegated as the coach.
- Registration shall start at 10:00 am and will end at 10:30 am. The program shall start shortly after registration.
- STRICTLY NO WALK-INS.

General Mechanics

- The participants must bring their own coloring materials. The event organizers will provide a
 ¼ size illustration board only. Only pencils, ballpens, markers, crayons, and oil pastels are
 allowed to be used.
- The theme of the poster will be given on the day of the contest.
- Each participant is given 1 hour and 30 minutes to finish his/her poster.
- STRICTLY NO TIME EXTENSIONS.

B. QUIZBOWL

Registration

- The contest is open to all secondary schools in Region XI.
- Each participating school must notify the organizing committee its intention to participate in the
 contest on or before February 24, 2020 through the contact details provided in the invitation
 letter.
- Each participating school is entitled to be represented by a team of three members. A standin for a regular member can be sent.
- Participants must be bona fide grade 9 or 10 students.
- Participants shall be in their prescribed uniform and shall wear their identification card upon registration and during the contest proper.
- Each participating school shall pay Php 300.00 as registration fee. Upon registration, the students must be accompanied by one (1) official school representative delegated as the coach.
- Registration shall start at 12:00 pm and will end at 1 pm (Simultaneous to the poster-making contest proper).
- STRICTLY NO WALK-INS.

General Mechanics

 PANAGTIGIAY 2019 shall be composed of three rounds: the Easy Round, the Average Round, and the Difficult Round. The questions in each round shall be within the scope of Food Science and Technology.


Round	Number of questions	Time Allotted	Corresponding points
Easy	15	10 seconds	1 point

Average	15	20 seconds	3 points
Difficult	10	30 seconds	5 points

- The table above shows the number of questions, time allotted and corresponding points for each round
- All teams are to participate in the Easy and Average round.
- · After the Average round, only the top five teams shall proceed to the Difficult round.
- · However, all teams are required to stay until the announcement of winners.
- Determination of the qualifying teams shall be done jointly by the judges and the organizing committee.
- Basis for winners shall be the cumulative points garnered by each team from all the rounds.

Answering Mechanics

- A white board, marker and eraser will be provided to the participants. Clean sheets of paper and pens shall be provided for questions requiring mathematical solving. However, each team must bring their own scientific calculator.
- Participants are only allowed to write their answers after the quizmaster says "Go". Any team
 caught writing before this shall forfeit their chance to answer the present question.
- Answers must be written legibly on the white board.
- Only complete answers will merit full credit. Incomplete and wrongly spelt answers shall be considered wrong answers.
- Should a question require a scientific name, only an answer that is written correctly shall be considered as correct answer.
- Participants must stop writing upon announcement of the quizmaster. A violation shall invalidate any answers for the present question.
- All teams shall raise their illustration boards with or without answer when the quizmaster announces "Boards up please".

Protest Mechanics

- A protest may be raised by any participant.
- All protests shall be forwarded to the judges for decision.
- During the protest, the contestant has the privilege of consulting any reference, provided they
 are relevant to the subject of the protest.
- Protests regarding a particular question will be entertained only before the next question is read.
- Once the next question is read, no protest regarding the previous question will be entertained.

Tie Breaking

- In case of a tie at the end of the last phase of this contest, a tiebreaker will immediately ensue.
- Questions of any difficulty and type will be asked until one contestant gains an advantage in score
 over the other.
- The first contestant to gain an advantage in score will be declared the victor of the tie and will
 merit the corresponding award.
- Scores for each question shall follow that of the Difficult round.

Winners

 At the conclusion of the contest, the second runner-up, first runner-up and the champion will be awarded with medals, certificates of recognition and cash prizes. The winners will receive Php 3,000.00 and Php 5,000.00, respectively.

 The participating coaches shall also be given certificates of participation. All participating schools shall receive certificates of appreciation.
