SUBJECT : ADVANCED TRAINING COURSE FOR TROOP LEADERS

 We are pleased to announce the conduct of Advanced Training Course for Troop Leaders with Davao del Norte Council as host.

2. Hereunder are the details of the training course for your information and guidance.

A. Courses:

a.1 ADVANCED TRAINING COURSE FOR TROOP LEADERS May 24-30, 2022

Angel Villarica Central Elem. Sch., Babak, Island Garden City of Samal

B. Qualifications for admission:

- Must be a Unit Leader and a graduate of BTC for Troop Leaders for the Troop Section.
- Must be currently registered as Troop Leader or Asst. Troop Leader.
- Must be physically fit as certified by a licensed physician.
- Must be fully vaccinated and it has been at least two (2) weeks since the last required dose.
- C. Registration Fee. An amount of Six Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P 6,500.00) shall be collected each participant, to cover accommodation, meals for the duration of the course, training materials, handouts and other incidental expenses, and must be paid in cash. The amount is chargeable against MOOE or other local funds available subject to the accounting rules and regulations.
- D. Reservation Fee. A non-refundable but transferable reservation fee of Three Thousand Pesos (P 3,000.00) shall be charged each participant to be paid on or before May 15, 2022. The remaining amount of Three Thousand Five Pesos (P 3,500.00) shall be paid upon registration at the training venue.
- E. Deadline of Submission: The attached Application to Attend must be supported with the duly accomplished Medical Examination Form and a photocopy of fully vaccinated card. Said documents shall be endorsed by the Council Scout Executive and Council Training Commissioner and must reach Regional Office 20 days before the start of the said course.
- F. Transportation Expenses: Transportation and other miscellaneous expenses incurred before the start of the course shall be borne by the participants or council from point of origin to the course venue.
- G. What to bring: Participants must bring along with them the following items:
 - g.1. Current Membership Card
 - g.2. Two pieces of recent photo ID (1 x 1) Type "A" uniform
 - g.3. At least two (2) sets of type "A" uniform.
 - g.3.a. Short Pants with Flap on Side Pockets for Female Troop Leaders and Short Pants for Male Troop Leaders, socks and garter tabs.
 - g.4. White T-shirt for type B uniform.
 - g.5. Sports Wear and personal gears/bedding.
 - g.6. Attire/Costume (Filipiniana) for socials.
 - g.7. Reference materials for Basic Training Course
 - g.8. Laptop (Optional)
- H. Reporting Date: Participants are required to report at the training venue on May 15, 2022 not later than 4:00 p.m. for registration and orientation.
