Steps for Interested Participants without DepEd Email Accounts

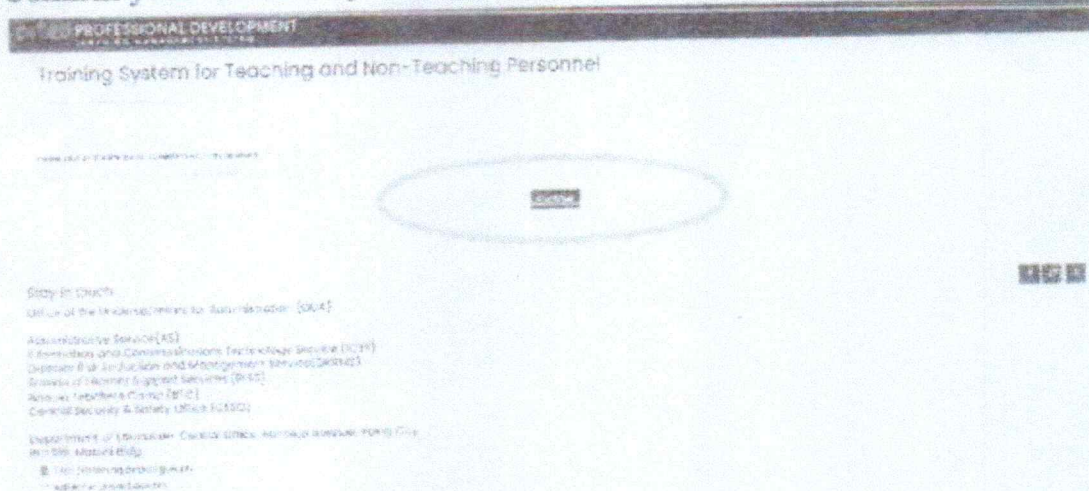
1. Go to <https://training.dep.ed.gov.ph> and type your log in credentials.
2. Click **Log in** and select **New Account**.




3. Enter your **personal details** then click **Create my new account** tab.

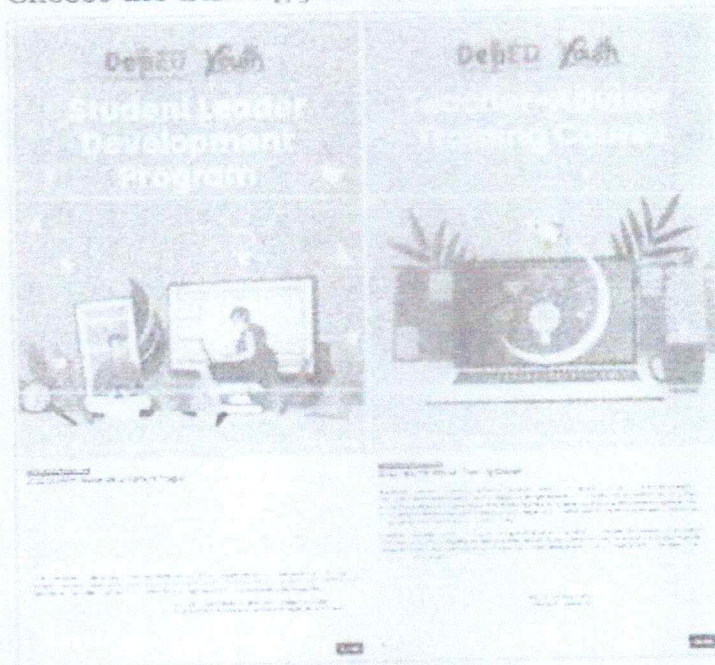
