CALL FOR PAPERS

The Asia Pacific Network for International Education and Values Education (APNIEVE) Philippines announces its 2018 Annual Convention with the theme, *Empowering Teachers towards Quality and Inclusive Values Education and International Education*. This theme is adapted from the 2017 World Teachers' Day theme, *Teaching in Freedom, Empowering Teachers* and from the Sustainable Development Goal 4 dedicated to education adopted in 2015.

Teaching in Freedom: Academic Freedom is critical for teachers at every level of education. But in many countries, academic freedom and teacher autonomy are under pressure.

Empowering Teachers: For every girl, boy, woman, and man, a highly skilled, valued, and empowered education workforce is the surest path to providing a quality education.

Teachers are at the Centre of the Right to Education: The guarantee of the right to education implies a fair distribution of knowledge, information, and skills and access to a quality and equitable education. This is why the Education 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development entrusts UNESCO to lead and coordinate Sustainable Development Goal (SDG)4, which commits Member States to "*ensure that teachers and educators are empowered, adequately recruited, well-trained, professionally qualified, motivated and supported within well resourced, efficient and effectively governed systems*" (<https://en.unesco.org/sites/default/files/wtd-2017-programme-en.pdf>).

Conference strands will revolve around the leading-edge thinking, research, and best practices revolving around the empowerment of teachers for quality and inclusive values education and international education in the 21st century. Challenges of and opportunities for values education and international education in a fast-paced world of changes in knowledge, technology and social interaction as well as in

times of political change, instability, and conflict, will be discussed by policymakers, administrators, researchers and teachers.

Presentations will focus on basic research, applied research, best practices, and module/lesson demonstrations. Please send your abstracts/essays (250 words) to apnieve.ph@gmail.com on or before February 28, 2018. Papers will be referred by a panel.

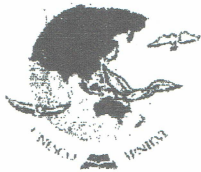
