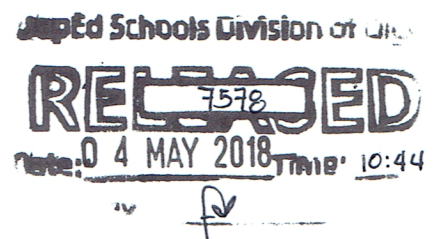

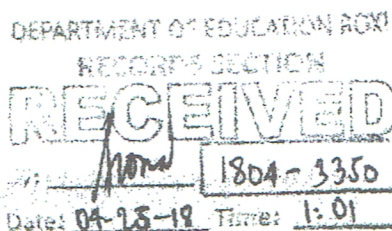

Interested participants will be guided by the following *Registration Procedures*:

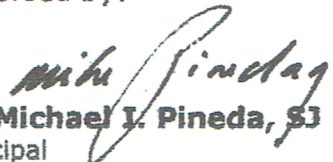
