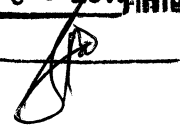

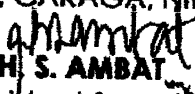

Regional Core of Trainers for the ALS GUIDELINES FOR SELECTION

FUNCTIONS OF REGIONAL CORE OF TRAINERS FOR THE ALS

The Regional Core of Trainer for the ALS is expected to:

1. Conduct ALS training for the ALS implementers
2. Educate/inform ALS implementers about ALS and related issues to it
3. Document every training conducted
4. Submit report on the trainings conducted
5. Liaise with DepED, community and other concerned agencies and organizations for technical/funding assistance for the trainings
6. Manage day-to-day operations of the training

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF REGIONAL CORE OF TRAINERS FOR THE ALS

The Regional Core of Trainer for the ALS must:	Proof of Claim
1. be Mobile Teacher, District ALS Coordinator, EPSA II, School Head or Division/Regional Supervisor	
2. be at least two(2) years in ALS service	Service Record
3. be not more than 50 years old at the time of training	Birth certificate
4. have good communication skills (mother tongue, Filipino/English)	Demonstrated skills through an interview, interview notes of evaluators
5. be a bonafide resident of the barangay or the community	Certification from the barangay captain
6. be willing to undergo training and serve as regional core of trainer	Written application or expression of interest
7. possess a great sense of responsibility and leadership skills	
8. be dynamic, flexible and trainable	
9. demonstrate an ability to listen, empathize and accept others	
10. demonstrate openness to receiving feedback and supervision	
11. be a team player and a positive role model	

GUIDELINES IN THE SELECTION OF REGIONAL ALS CORE OF TRAINERS FOR THE ALS

1. The Selection Committee in each region will be composed of the Regional Supervisors.
2. The enumerated criteria and the expected functions of the Regional Core of Trainer will serve as guide in the selection and final decision of the Selection Committee.
3. The Selection Committee will submit the selection results to the Regional ALS Focal Person. The Regional ALS Focal Person will facilitate endorsement to the Regional Director for approval and transmission to the BCD-SPD.
