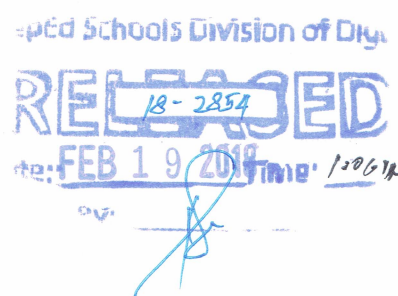

DATE : **12 FEBRUARY 2018**

1. To strengthen the implementation of the various DepEd issuances on Child Protection, such as DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 (DepEd Child Protection Policy), DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2013 (Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Anti-Bullying Act of 2013) and DepEd Order No. 18, s. 2015 (DepEd Guidelines and Procedures on the Management of Children-At-Risk (CAR) and Children in Conflict with the Law (CICL), the Office of the Undersecretary for Legal Affairs will be conducting the National Training for Child Protection Specialists (CPS) – Level II.
2. The National Training for CPS aims to equip the participants with the knowledge, skills, and attitudes to provide the necessary assistance in the schools within the CPS's respective Regions and Divisions. Upon completion of the training, it is expected that the CPS will be able to efficiently assist and ensure school compliance of all the requirements laid by the aforementioned DepEd issuances and other laws related to Child Protection.
3. The National Training is scheduled on **20-23 February 2018** in **National Educators Academy of the Philippines - Davao**, Elpidio Quirino Avenue, Poblacion District, Davao City, Davao del Sur.

4. The list of selected participants for the National Training is attached as Annex A of this Memorandum. For your guidance, the Administrative Notes and Program of Activities are attached as Annex B and C, respectively.

2. The participants for the training were selected on the basis of their performance during the First Level National Training of Trainers on Child Protection.
3. The participants are expected to have knowledge of the basic concepts and policies on child protection, having attended the First Level National Training of Trainers Child Protection. Likewise, everyone is expected to actively participate in the workshops and discussions.
