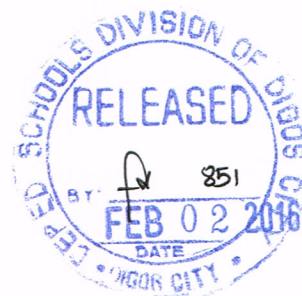

# MECHANICS FOR JUDGING

## \* Quiz Bee

1. The contest is open to all kindergarten pupils in Digos City Division.
2. Each District of the said division has 1 entry.  
(Digos Occidental District, Digos Oriental District and Mt. Apo District)
3. Each entry has one participant.
4. Participants will provide their white board where they will write down their answer, a marker and an eraser.
5. There will be three (3) categories: **Easy, Average and Difficult** round with the total score of thirty (30) points.  
**Easy Round: 5 questions - 1 point each = 5**  
**Average Round: 5 questions - 2 points each = 10 points**  
**Difficult Round: 5 questions - 3 points each = 15 points**  
**Total = 30 points**
6. The questions are focused on the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter from week 21 to week 32.
7. The quiz master will read the question twice to the participants and they are given ten (10) sec. to write down their answer on the board.
8. The participants, will be ranked on the TOTAL points he earned.
9. In case of a tie score/points, five (5) questions will be given and the one who gets the highest points wins.



# MECHANICS FOR JUDGING

## \* Poster Making

1. The contest is open to all kindergarten pupils in Digos City Division.
2. Each District of the said division has 3 entries  
(Digos Occidental District, Digos Oriental District and Mt. Apo District)
3. The poster must illustrate, interpret and emphasize the theme “**Ako at Ang Aking Kapaligiran**”.
4. Each contestant has 1 hour to draw his/her piece.
5. The following materials will be used in the contest:
  - a. oslo paper and a mongol pencil (to be provided by the contestant)
  - b. Coloring material:
    - oil pastel (to be provided by the contestant)
    - \*Use of other materials not specified above is strictly prohibited.
6. The posters will be judged according to the following criteria:
  - Creativity and presentation - 40%**
  - Originality - 30%**
  - Relevance to the theme - 30%**

# MECHANICS FOR JUDGING

## \* Spelling

1. The contest is open to all kindergarten pupils in Digos City Division.
2. Each District of the said division has 1 entry.  
(Digos Occidental District, Digos Oriental District and Mt. Apo District)
3. Participants will be given a piece of paper and he/she will provide his/her own pencil and eraser.
4. There will be three (3) categories: **Easy, Average and Difficult** rounds with the total score of thirty (30) points.  
**Easy Round: 5 questions - 1 point each = 5**  
**Average Round: 5 questions - 2 points each = 10 points**  
**Difficult Round: 5 questions - 3 points each = 15 points**  
**Total = 30 points**
5. The questions are focused on the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter from week 21 to week 32 and sight words.
6. The quiz master will read the words and participants are given ten (10) seconds to spell the word.
7. Pupils will be ranked according to the number of correct spelled words.
8. The pupil who will get the most number of correct spelled words wins.
9. A tie breaking round (5 words) will be given if in case there will be a tie score among the participants.



# MECHANICS FOR JUDGING

## \* Vocal Solo (Tagalog and Bisaya)

1. The contest is open to all kindergarten pupils in Digos City Division.
  2. Each District of the said division has 1 entry/event.  
(Digos Occidental District, Digos Oriental District and Mt. Apo District)
  3. Contestants will free to choose any song appropriate for children.
  4. Performance time is 3-5 minutes including entrance and exit. Beyond this limit, a total of 5 points will be deducted from the his/her total score.
  5. Minus one or any musical instrument can be used as accompaniment, however, contestants are allowed to sing without accompaniment.
  6. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:
    - a. Voice and quality projection - 25%
    - b. Rhythm - 15%
    - c. Dynamics - 15%
    - d. Diction - 15%
    - e. Mastery - 20%
    - f. Showmanship - 10%

## \*Poem Recitation (English & Filipino)

1. The contest is open to all kindergarten pupils in Digos City Division.
  2. Each District of the said division has 1 entry/event.  
(1 entry for poem to be recited in English) and 1 entry for tula (to be recited in Filipino)  
(Digos Occidental District, Digos Oriental District and Mt. Apo District)
  3. Each contestant will recite any piece of his/her choice appropriate for children.
  4. Performance time is 3-5 minutes including entrance and exit. Beyond this limit, a total of 5 points will be deducted from the total score.
  5. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:
    - a. Voice Clarity and projection - 25%
    - b. Diction - 20%
    - c. Interpretation - 25%
    - d. Mastery - 25%
    - e. Costume - 5%

## \* Dance Sports Competition

1. The competition is open to all kindergarten pupils in Digos City Division.
  2. Each District has 1 entry (1pair: 1 male and 1 female)
  3. Each entry (1 pair) is free to choose their own music piece, steps, and dance costume.
  4. Participants will perform medley: swing, cha-cha and boogie only.
  4. Performance time is 3-5 minutes including entrance and exit. Beyond this limit, a total of 5 points will be deducted from the pair's total score.
  5. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:
    - a. Mastery and coordination - 30%
    - b. Choreography - 25%
    - c. Grace and footwork - 25%
    - d. Costume - 10%
    - e. Audience Impact - 10%

## \*Chorus Competition

1. The contest is open to all kindergarten pupils in Digos City Division.
2. Each District has 1 entry with 10 pupils
3. Each entry will sing the “Digosenio Hymn”
4. Performance time is 3-5 minutes including entrance and exit. Beyond this limit, a total of 5 points will be deducted from the group’s total score.
5. Minus one or any musical instrument can be used as accompaniment, however contestants are allowed to sing without accompaniment.
6. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:
  - a. Voice and quality projection - 25%
  - b. Rhythm - 15%
  - c. Dynamics - 15%
  - d. Diction - 15%
  - e. Mastery - 20%
  - f. Showmanship - 10%

# MECHANICS FOR JUDGING

## \* Folk Dance Competition

1. The competition is open to all kindergarten pupils in Digos City Division.
  2. Each District has 1 entry with 10 pupils (5 pairs: 5 male and 5 female)
  3. Participants will perform the Cariñosa.
  4. Performance time is 3-5 minutes including entrance and exit. Beyond this limit, a total of 5 points will be deducted from the group's total score.
  5. Big props for the stage and any other form of back drops are not allowed on the stage. Dancers will use props that will be handled only.
  6. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:
    - a. **Mastery** (correct execution of steps and timing with the music) - **30%**
    - b. **Choreography** (balance/proper/distances/alignment) - **25%**
    - c. **Costumes** - **20%**
    - d. **Projection and Expression** (poise and grace) - **25%**

# MECHANICS FOR JUDGING

## \* Story Telling (Bisaya)

1. The contest is open to all kindergarten pupils in Digos City Division.
2. Each District of the said division has 1 entry  
(Digos Occidental District, Digos Oriental District and Mt. Apo District)
3. Each contestant will recite any piece of his/her choice appropriate for children.
4. Each contestant will be given 3-5 minutes to deliver the piece or story. Beyond this limit, a total of 5 points will be deducted from the total score.
5. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:
  - a. Pronunciation - 25%
  - b. Voice variations and projection - 20%
  - c. Content and Logical presentation of events - 20%
  - d. Skills in eliciting emotions and expressions of the character played - 25%
  - a. Impact - 10%

# MECHANICS FOR JUDGING

## \* Modern Dance Competition

- 1. The competition is open to all kindergarten pupils in Digos City Division.
- 2. Each District has 1 entry. Each entry/group will have a minimum of ten (10) members.
- 3. The members of the groups maybe composed of all males or females, or any combination thereof.
- 4. The dance number must have an accompaniment of any music, which is modern and lively.
- 5. Performance time is 3-5 minutes including entrance and exit. Beyond this limit, a total of 5 points will be deducted from the group's total score.
- 6. Folk dances or accompaniment of folk music is not allowed.
- 7. The use of pyrotechnic gadgets, a smoke or combustible material as props is not allowed.
- 4. The winners will be chosen based on the following criteria:
  - a. Mastery - 30%
  - b. Choreography - 25%
  - c. Costumes - 20%
  - d. Originality - 20%
  - e. Audience Impact - 5%
