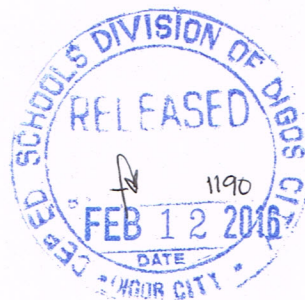

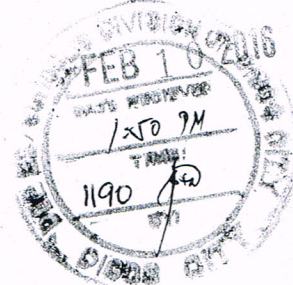

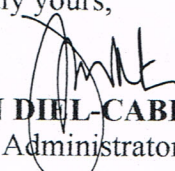
The following is the schedule of the registration fee:

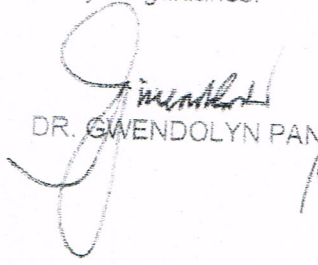
