FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2018 – 2019**

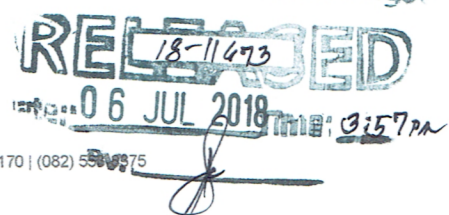

1. DepEd launches the *Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education (OK sa DepEd)* which is a convergence of DepEd's health programs, plans, policies, and activities for effective and efficient implementation at the school level, in partnership with various stakeholders. *OK sa DepEd* shall focus on DepEd's major school health programs such as the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP), National Drug Education Program (NDEP), Adolescent Reproductive Health Education (ARH), Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS), and Medical, Dental, and Nursing Services. Other health and nutrition programs will continue to be implemented in support of these five flagship programs.
