Mental Health and Positive Psychology

In this time of globalization, disruption and complexities that is happening in the environment, mental health programs anchored with Positive Psychology in collaboration with different stakeholders from the school, industry and community settings play a substantial role in the awareness and prevention of mental health problems. It is a must for all guidance counselors, psychologists and other helping professionals to be equipped in knowing how to make and facilitate responsive, accountable, advocacy driven, evidence-based, and effective mental health programs that are all for the welfare of the psychological well-being of children, youth, employees, families, and communities.

Working with the Suicidal: The Solution Focused Approach

This workshop refreshes participants with the basics of Solution Focused Approach based on Solution Focused Brief Therapy of Insoo Kim Berg and Steve de Shazer. Participants will be equipped with a range of specialized solution focused tools and techniques in handling suicidal clients, which both reduces the likelihood of further suicidal thinking and, at the same time, reduces the sense of burden on the health professional. Through lectures and simulations, participants will practice the tools learned from the workshop.
