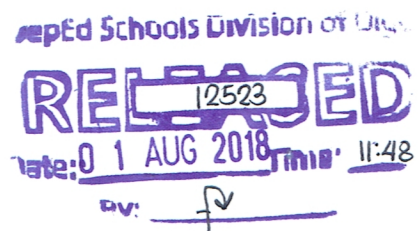

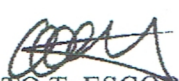
1. Bansalan CES, Davao del sur

The nominated pilot schools will be provided by CPPI with toothbrushes, toothpaste, oral health education materials and fluoride varnish.

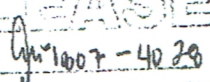
Attached with this Unnumbered memorandum is the PACC Guidelines, PACC certificate of turnover form and certificate of Acceptance form.

**PHILIPPINE ANTI CAVITY CAMPAIGN
GUIDELINES
School Engagement**

OBJECTIVES:

- To Provide sustainable Oral Health program that will focus to reduce number of children with dental caries.
- To Instill and Innovate system of Oral Health Education necessary, practical and beneficial to Parents, Teachers and others health workers.
- To Promote engagement and interaction with key stakeholders and other agencies who will collaborate and participate in this program.

TARGET PATIENTS:

- Maximum of 1,000 patients from Kindergartens up to Grade 3 for 1 elementary school.

TARGET PARTICIPATING PUBLIC HEALTH DENTISTS & OTHER PERSONNEL:

- Minimum of 5 Public School Dentists
- School personnels (nurse/nutritionist)
- School Principal
- Class Advisers

ROLES:

Colgate will provide toothbrush, toothpastes, dental health records, product samples, flip charts & posters.

Public Health Dentists will provide oral health education, free dental check-up/consultation, dental treatment (fluoride treatment, pits & fissure sealants, restorations) and other necessary dental materials.

School Principal will provide venue & audio-visual equipment, security of volunteers, equipment & instruments.

Class Advisers will continue to conduct classroom oral health education and oral health activities atleast 1 per month.

GENERAL GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES:

1. Choose one (1) Elementary School, preferably with good location/venue and can accommodate 1,000 people. It should be easy to locate for Colgate merchandisers and Colgate project coordinators.
2. All DepEd Dentist shall be guided with the following scenarios:

- a. If Kinder to Grade 3 will be less than 1000 = Dentist can extend the program to other grade levels until it reach the target number
3. Submission of selected venue and activity plan will be on or before November 15, 2017. Please submit all the details to the _____.
4. All activities will be done on the following dates:
 - February 26, 2018 to March 28, 2018 – Launching and first phase of the dental treatments
 - Submission of Phase 1 report = April 16, 2018
 - April 1, 2018- May 31, 2018 –Follow up and monitoring of the activity
 - Submission of other Monitoring Report = June 16, 2018
 - July 1, 2018- September 30, 2018 – Second phase of the dental treatments for the community
 - Submission of Phase 2 report = October 16, 2018
 - October 1, 2018- November 30, 2018 - Final visit and evaluation
 - Submission of all remaining monitoring report = January 16, 2019
5. Make necessary coordination with the officials of your chosen school.
6. Provide an area in the venue where the volunteer dentists can conduct oral health lectures, toothbrushing drill, free dental check-up/consultation, topical fluoride application, and other dental services.
7. Event tarpaulins will be posted in the area.
8. Registration on the day of the event will be handled by School personnel with the help of barangay officials and barangay health workers.
9. Volunteer dentists will conduct oral health examination and education, toothbrushing drill and fluoride application to the students.
10. _____ tubes of Duraphat Fluoride varnish and micro applicators will be provided by Colgate. (
*Please see Special Instructions for Duraphat below.
11. Maximum of 1,000 students can avail the free dental check-up. Check-ups will be on a first come first serve basis.
12. Colgate samples will be provided for a maximum of 1,000 patients per school.
13. Colgate samples and other logistics materials will be sent to the division offices thru courier service on the following dates:
 - March 5, 2018
 - May 1-30, 2018
14. Search for zero (0) cavity kids
15. The volunteer dentists can render other dental services provided that they have the necessary materials needed for the service, be it preventive or curative services.
16. Colgate t-shirts and gift packs will be given to ten (10) public health dentists and Dental Aides.
17. Written report of your activity must be submitted to the regional coordinator thru e-mail, with at least 2-5 4R pictures with captions. With the following deadline dates:

- April 16, 2018
- June 16, 2018
- October 16, 2018
- January 16, 2019

18. Quarterly newsletter will be sent to the Regional and Division offices. This will contain all the activities that were accomplished by the participating municipalities & schools.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS: Duraphat Varnish Product Information and Proper Storage Instruction.

1. QUALITATIVE AND QUANTITATIVE COMPOSITION

- 1 ml of suspension contains 50mg Sodium Fluoride equivalent to 22.6mg of Fluoride.

2. PHARMACEUTICAL FORM

- Dental Suspension

*Administration to be done by licensed professional dentists. Refer to Method of Administration and Precautions for Use cited in Duraphat Product Information leaflet

3. CONTRAINDICATIONS

Hypersensitivity to colophony and/or any other constituents

Ulcerative Gingivitis

Stomatitis

Bronchial Asthma

4. INTERACTIONS WITH OTHER MEDICAMENTS AND OTHER FORMS OF INTERACTIONS

The presence of alcohol in the Duraphat formula should be considered.

5. SHELF LIFE

Unopened 3 years. For aluminium tube; after opening, use within 3 months.

6. SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS FOR STORAGE

Do not store above 25 degrees Celsius.

Efficacy and Safety of Fluoride Varnish:

1. Marinho et al, Fluoride varnishes for preventing dental caries in children and adolescents (Review), Cochrane Review 2013, Issue 7

"In the 13 trials that looked at children and adolescents with permanent teeth the review found that the young people treated with fluoride varnish experienced on average a 43% reduction in decayed, missing and filled tooth surfaces. In the 10 trials looking at the effect of fluoride varnish on first or baby teeth the evidence suggests a 37% reduction in decayed, missing and filled tooth surfaces. There was little information concerning possible adverse effects or acceptability of treatment."

2. Study on Fluoride Varnish Efficacy in Preventing Early Childhood caries by J.A Weintraub, F. Ramos-Gomez, B. Jue, S. Shain, C.I Hoover, J.D.B. Featherstone, and S.A Gansky published J Dent Res. 2006 February; (a) Review on Fluoride Varnish in Caries Prevention by Liisa Seppa published at Med Princ Pract 2004

"A statistically significant reduction in caries incidence was observed in a clinical trial conducted at two public health centers on children ages 6-44 months. It was concluded, among others, that "no related adverse events were reported. Fluoride Varnish added to caregiver counselling is efficacious in reducing early childhood caries incidence"; (a) The NaF varnish Duraphat is effective in caries prevention and safe for children and adolescents."
