Two-Day Workshop on Finalizing Contextualized Lesson Plans for Implementation for SY 2018-2019

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 62, s.2011 entitled Adopting the National Indigenous Peoples Education (IPEd) Policy framework and DepEd Order No. 43, s.2013 entitled Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic act No.10533 Otherwise known as the Enhanced Basic Education act of 2013, the Department of Education (DepEd) is adopting the Indigenous Peoples Education Curriculum Framework. Recognizing the right of IPs to basic education that is culturally rooted and responsive, the IPEd Curriculum Framework seeks to provide guidance to schools and other education programs, both public and private, as they engage with ICCs in localizing, indigenizing, and enhancing the K to 12 Curriculum based on their respective educational and social contexts.
2. Based on the above premise, the Digos City Division will be conducting a two –day activity on **August 11-12, 2018** with the following objectives:
 - a. To enhance the national curriculum in relation to the community life cycle while recognizing appropriate scope and sequence of competencies;
 - b. To inter-relate the competencies in enhancing the curriculum and teaching-learning process;
 - c. To recognize the community as the wider space, environment, and resource of learning; and
 - d. To incorporate the community's narratives of local and national history and contemporary issues and concerns confronted by the IPs (Thus, the participation of the IP elders, and other culture-bearers during the training)
3. Deped Teaching and Non-Teaching personnel shall earn Compensatory Overtime Credits or Service Credits for attending the training scheduled on Saturday and Sunday (per DO 53, s. 2003). List of participants are found in the enclosure.
4. Participants are expected to be at the **Arnaldo's Hotel, Rizal Avenue, Digos City** at eight o'clock (8:00am) in the morning for the opening program.
