REGIONAL ENHANCEMENT TRAINING IN CAMPUS JOURNALISM

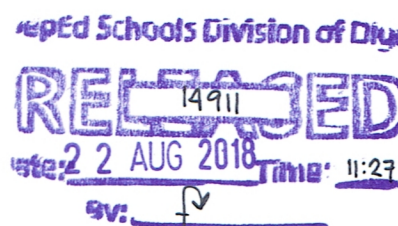

REGIONAL ENHANCEMENT TRAINING IN CAMPUS JOURNALISM

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Pursuant to Republic Act (RA) No. 7079, also known as the "Campus Journalism Act of 1991," the Department of Education Regional Office XI through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) in collaboration with the Davao Region School Paper Advisers Association (DRSPAA) will conduct a Regional Enhancement Training in Campus Journalism on August 24-26, 2018 at Saint Mary's College of Tagum, Inc., Tagum City.
2. This training aims to:
 - a) update the participants on effective school paper management and the different writing techniques;
 - b) provide a venue for an enriching, learning experience for school paper advisers (SPA) in crafting school publication for higher level competition;
 - c) enhance the capacity of school paper advisers (SPAs) in honing the journalistic skills of potential contestants; and
 - d) gain technique in producing a winning school paper and competitive campus journalists.
3. All Schools Division Offices (SDOs) shall send delegates from both public and private schools. Specifically, each SDO shall send 25 school paper advisers and 25 campus journalists from both levels elementary and secondary and media English and Filipino.
4. Since this is a live-in training and the registration is free, all participants are advised to:
 - a) bring their own beddings; and
 - b) wear school ID and proper attire.
5. The Division Journalism Coordinators are also enjoined to attend the said activity.

6. Travel expenses of the regional personnel shall be charged against Regional Funds while transportation and other incidental expenses of the Division/School participants shall be charged against, MOOE, SEF, Journalism and other local funds, all subject to the accounting rules and auditing procedures.
7. Teaching and non-teaching participants are entitled to service credits and Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) respectively per DepEd Order no. 53, s. 2003, "Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers."
8. Prompt and immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
