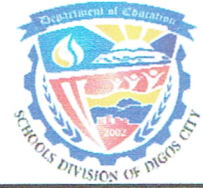

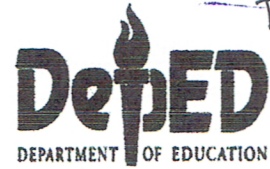

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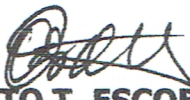
MEMORANDUM

REGIONAL PUBLICATION FOR PROJECT EAGLE (Project EYRIE)

TO: Schools Division Superintendents

1.
