1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 1906, series of 2009, **October is declared as the "National Indigenous Peoples Month"**. DepEd Memorandum No. 128, series of 2018, sets the theme for this year's celebration as **"Ugnayan ng DepEd at Pamayanan Pagtibayin sa Pangalawang Dekada ng Pagsulong sa Katutubong Edukasyon"**. In observance of, and in solidarity with the Indigenous Cultural Communities of Digos City, the City Schools Division of Digos will hold the **2018 Panaghiusa Festival on October 12, 2018 in Balabag Elementary School**.
2. The one-day festival aims to showcase the different tribal games and Indigenous Knowledge Systems and Practices (IKSPs) of the IP Elders and learners in Digos City.

2. Karang (Secondary – Male)	• 5 Players per school • Bring own sets of Karang at least 1 foot in height with Abaca/Rattan as pantali.
3. Papana/Busog (Secondary - Male)	• 1 Player per school • Bring own materials
4. Tot-ho (Secondary – Male)	• 1 Player per school/category • Bring own materials
5. Bunong Braso (Secondary – Male)	• 1 Player per school • Physique matching
6. Kalisong (Elementary and Secondary – Male)	• 3 Players per school/category • Bring own materials (Bunot and Kawayan)
7. Labu – labo (Elementary – Female)	• 5 Players per school • Bring own materials
8. Panik sa Kawayan (Elementary – Male)	• 3 Players per school
