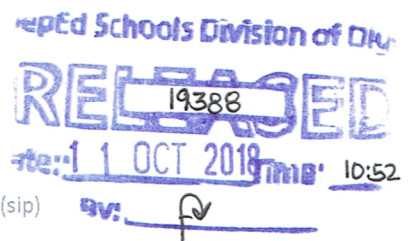
**Attendance to the Two-Day Orientation Workshop on the

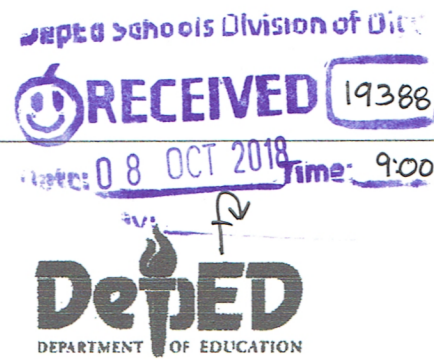
