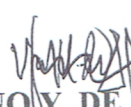

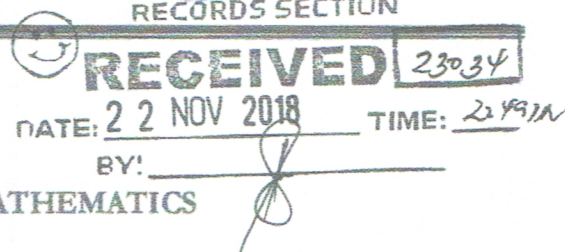

SUBJECT : **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR MATHEMATICS
LEARNING AREA COMPETITIONS**

DATE : June 19, 2018



1. In pursuance to the issued Regional Memorandum relative to the conduct of the 2018 Regional Festival of Talents, this Office informs the final schedule and venue of the Regional Math Quiz, Strategic Intervention Material and Rubik's Cube Competitions for Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools on November 29-30, 2018 to December 1, 2018 at Tagum City National High School, Tagum City.

2. The conduct of the Regional Festival of Talents in the Mathematics Learning Area aims to:

For the learners:

- 2.1 enhance students' academic excellence in Mathematics;
- 2.2 develop mastery of basic mathematical competencies;
- 2.3 hone comprehension, analytical and reasoning skills of pupils/students; and
- 2.4 inculcate the values of hard work, perseverance, honesty and sportsmanship.

For the teachers:

- 2.5 construct creatively low cost multi-level Instructional Materials (IMs) in Mathematics
- 2.6 develop IMs meant to reteach concepts and skills; and
- 2.7 provide materials to learners to help them master a competency-based skill which they were not able to develop during the regular classroom teaching (with minimal intervention/guide of a teacher)

3. The contests shall include the following:

3.1 Mathematics Quiz (Individual Category)

– **Division Top 2 winners**

- Elementary Level - Grades 3-6
- Secondary Level - Grades 7-12

3.2 Rubik's Cube Competition (Individual Category)

– **Division Top 2 winners**

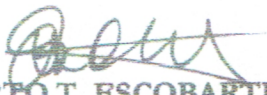
- Elementary Level - Grades 3-6
- Secondary Level - Grades 7-12

3.3 Strategic Intervention Material Competition (Teacher Category)

– **Division Top 1 winner in the combined Grade Level**

- Elementary Level - Grades 1-2, 3-4, 5-6
- Secondary Level - Grades 7-8, 9-10, 11-12

4. Participants to these competitions are the Top 2 winners of the Division Math Quiz (Grades 3-12) and the Division Top 1 winner of the SIM Competition in each combined Grade Level (Grades 1-12). List of the Division Participants including names of learners, teachers, coaches and Education Program Supervisors/Mathematics Coordinators must be submitted on or before November 29, 2018.
5. Matrix of the Activity, Contest Mechanics, and Technical Working Committees are hereto attached for your reference.
6. Traveling expenses, board and lodging, and other allowable expenses of all the participants shall be charged against their local funds, while the honorarium of judges shall be charged against the Regional Office Funds, all subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Teacher-participants, coaches and non-teaching personnel are entitled to service credits and compensatory time-off (CTO), respectively, for services rendered during holidays, Saturdays and Sundays. Said privileges are in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 on *Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers* and Civil Service Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on *Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered*.
8. Immediate and wide dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum to all concerned is hereby enjoined.
