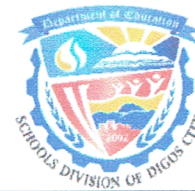

 - c. Employment opportunities through the jobs fair;
 - d. Processing of scholarship application by CHED and other agencies; and
 - e. Career guidance for incoming freshmen.
3. Transportation and other incidental expenses of the teacher advisers and learners shall be charged to local/school MOOE funds and other sources of funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

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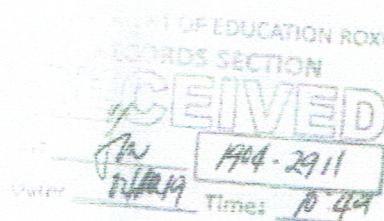

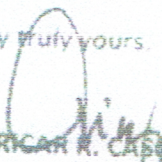
