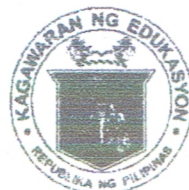

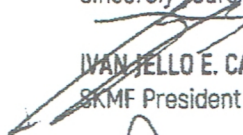

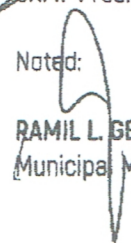

GENERAL GUIDELINES

The Local Government Unit of Monkayo through the Municipal Youth Development Unit, Monkayo College of Arts, Sciences, and Technology and Municipal Planning and Development Office, and co-presented by the Scholarus Solutions, Inc. organized the conduct of **1st Pagmaan-maan Multidisciplinary Research Conference** with the theme **'Researches of the Youth: Moving Forward for Innovation and Transformation'** on **August 15, 2019**, to be held at **Monkayo Dome, Poblacion, Monkayo, Compostela Valley, Philippines**.

The LGU-Monkayo invites youth researchers and students within the region to participate in the one-day conference which aim to further educate participants on the current trends and issues in the fields of (1) education, governance and social sciences; (2) environment, health, science and technology; and, (3) business and economics. Furthermore, youth research enthusiasts are encouraged to submit their research entries for the Oral and Poster Presentation.

Qualifications

1. Researches to be presented must be original, unpublished, and completed within the last two (2) years.
2. Ideally, the Presenter should be the First Author. If the First Author is not available, the presenter must be at least one of the co-authors of the paper.
3. Presenter/s should be present during the 1st Pagmaan-maan Multidisciplinary Research Conference.
4. Pre-registration is required for presenters and registration is FREE.

Submission of Abstracts

1. Abstracts must be submitted electronically to info@monkayo.gov.ph
2. In the subject line, use the following format: PAGMAAN-MAAN 2019 Abstract: Last Name, Institution (ex: PAGMAAN-MAAN 2019 Abstract: Crizaldo, Monkayo NHS)
3. In the body of the email, please indicate the following: Presentation Title, Author/s: (underline the presenter's name), Institution, Correspondents' email address. Indicate also if the presenting author is an junior or senior high school student, college student, and college graduate.
4. All abstracts should be written in English following the format in the Pagmaan-maan 2019 Abstract Template.
5. The Pagmaan-maan Scientific Committee will screen the submitted abstracts deemed for oral or poster presentation.
6. The corresponding author will be notified of acceptance and schedule of presentation thru email.
7. Submit also a one-page curriculum vitae or biography of the presenter.

Awards

1. Oral and Poster presentations will be judged during the 1st Pagmaan-maan Multidisciplinary Research Conference by Technical Evaluators chosen by the Pagmaan-maan Technical Committee.

2. The top three (3) best oral and top three (3) best student poster presentation winners will be chosen by the Technical Evaluators.
3. The decision of the Oral and Poster Technical Evaluators is final.
4. The winners will be announced, and their certificates and cash prizes will be given during the Awarding Ceremony at 1st Pagmaan-maan Multidisciplinary Research Conference.

Guidelines in the Preparation of Abstract for Technical Paper and Poster Presentation

An abstract is indicative of final paper quality; therefore, authors are urged to prepare quality abstracts. It should contain NOT more than 250 words and written in word format. Use 12-point Bookman Old Style font, typewritten double space and a margin of 1 inch on the top, bottom, left and right.

Title

It should be centered, bold, and in the upper and lower cases.

Author

The author names are typewritten in bold, lower case except the first letter, and placed below the title. The authors should follow the following format: An asterisk should be affixed to the name of the author presenting the paper. The complete postal and email addresses, telephone and/or facsimile numbers of the author to whom correspondence should be addresses should be written below the author names. If authors are from different institutions indicate with superscripts respective affiliations.

Body

The abstract body must represent the content of all the main sections of the paper. This section should briefly but clearly state the main objectives and scope of research work, describe the principal methodology and summarize the main findings and their significance.

Key Words

Written below the ABSTRACT are three to five key words or short words or short phrases that can be used for indexing your paper. Arrange these in alphabetical order.

The abstract and application should be emailed on or before **July 19, 2019** at info@monkayo.gov.ph. An acknowledgement receipt will be sent to the author upon receive of the abstract. There is no guarantee that the abstract will be accepted by the Pagmaan-maan Conference Technical Committee. If the abstract is accepted, the Committee Chair will send notification on or before July 26, 2019 to the corresponding author. The format and guidelines for the preparation of the technical paper/poster abstract should be strictly followed.

Guidelines for Oral Preparation

Length and Format of PowerPoint Presentation

- Presentation must be no longer than 12 minutes.
- Presentation must be in MS Office Powerpoint 2007 or later version (landscape orientation).
- Font size should be large enough to be seen clearly at the rear of the conference hall.
- Product endorsements are not allowed during the scientific session.
- There is NO EXCUSE for using more than your allotted time. Rehearse your presentation several times; projecting slides and doing anything else you would otherwise expect to do at the meeting. It is a discourtesy to your audience, the Session Chair and the other speakers to exceed your allotted time. The Session Chairs are instructed to adhere to the printed schedule for the session.

Day of Oral Presentation

- The presenting author must be present at the assigned date and time.
- Please register at the Secretariat table upon arrival at the venue to be provided with an ID.
- Submit a soft copy of the PowerPoint presentation to the Scientific Conference Chair before 8:00 A.M. on the day of presentation (presentation may also be emailed ahead of time). Make sure a backup copy is at hand. Should you wish to review your presentation please ask the protocol person for assistance.
- The presenter is allotted 12 minutes for oral presentation and 3 minutes for question and answer. A protocol officer will assist you during the presentation.
- The three (3) Technical Evaluators will be present during the presentation.
- Presenter will be given a Certificate of Paper Presentation during the 1st Pagmaan-maan Multidisciplinary Research Conference.

Guidelines for Poster Preparation

A poster presentation allows a youth researcher to provide a visual summary of their research to be displayed for sharing with conference delegates. There will be dedicated time allocated in the conference program for poster viewing by delegates and also an opportunity for poster presenters to be available to discuss their work with conference delegates on an individual basis.

General aim and format

A poster is a graphically based approach to presenting research. In presenting your research with a poster, you should aim to use the poster as a means for generating active discussion of the research. Limit the text to about one-fourth of the poster space, and use "visuals" (graphs, photographs, schematics, maps, etc.) to tell your "story."

Design and layout specifications

Total poster size must fit within a maximum space of 65 centimeters in width and 100 centimeters in height. Contents of poster should be divided into topics but must fit the specified poster panel size.

- Poster should include the title, names of author/s, affiliate institution/s of author/s.
- The text, tables, figures, etc. should be clear enough to be read from a distance of two meters. Use a minimum font size of 18 points. Lettering for the title should be large (at least 70-point font). Use all capital letters for the title.
- Make headings: INTRODUCTION, OBJECTIVES, MATERIALS AND METHODS, RESULTS, CONCLUSION, REFERENCES AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT and should state briefly and clearly.
- Present numerical data in the form of graphs, rather than tables. If data must be presented in table-form, keep it simple.
- Visuals should be simple and bold. Leave out or remove any unnecessary details. Make sure that any visual can "stand alone".
- Use color to enhance comprehension, not to decorate the poster. Neatly coloring black-line illustrations with color pencils is entirely acceptable.
- Make sure that the text and the visuals are integrated. Figures should be numbered consecutively according to the order in which they are first mentioned in the text.
- Each visual should have a brief title

Schedule of installing of poster is at 7:30 AM – 8:30 AM on August 15, 2019 and dismantling of poster is at 5:00 PM of the same day.

The presenter will be given a Certificate of Poster Presentation during the 1st Pagmaan-maan Multidisciplinary Research Conference.
