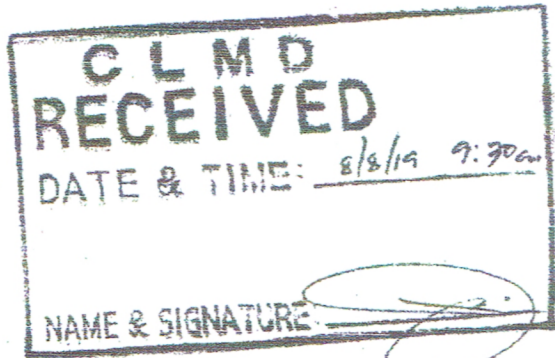

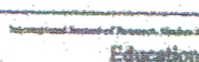

Research Contest Mechanics

1. The Research Contest is open to all Senior High School students and College students who are actively engaged in research.
2. Individual researchers or a group composed of three members may participate in the research contest.
3. The research method can be qualitative, quantitative or mixed.
4. Individual researchers or groups may submit more than one research paper.
5. The research paper can be in English or Filipino. It must be recommended by the adviser.
6. Exemplary researchers or awardees will receive a certificate.
7. The Sibol Organizing Committee expects the research contest participants to have parental consent (when applicable) and accompanied by the research adviser or an adult chaperone during the conference.
8. Exemplary research papers may be published in the partner journals of Lumina Foundation, namely Asia Pacific Journal of Multidisciplinary Journal and International Journal of Research in Education.
