CDRC is a non-stock non-profit non-government organization duly registered with the Securities and Exchange Commission.

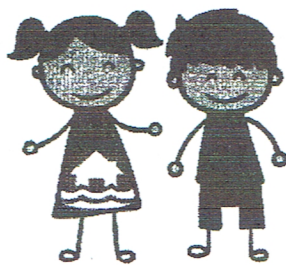
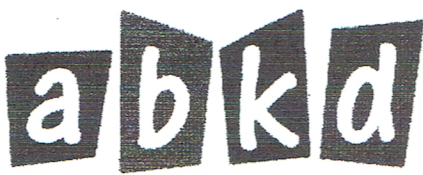
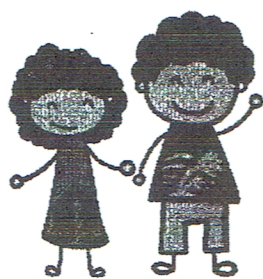

WINNERS

Two (2) major prize winners and four winners from each category will be selected.

Awarding of winners is on the first week of October 2019 (to be announced).

Winners will be informed through phone or by letter.

Major prize winners will get Php5,000 cash prize each. Other winners will receive Php1,000 each.

Prizes not claimed within six (6) months will be forfeited.

Winning entries shall become CDRC property and will be featured in the 2020 CDRC Disaster Preparedness Calendar and other promotional materials.

Non-winning entries can be reclaimed at the CDRC office. Entries not claimed within 60 days after the announcement of winners shall be considered donations to CDRC.

CONTEST LIMITS

Each participant can submit a maximum of two (2) entries.

Two-time winners of previous ABKD competitions can no longer join.

Posters that have won or have been submitted in other contests will not be accepted.
