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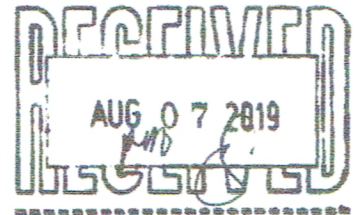

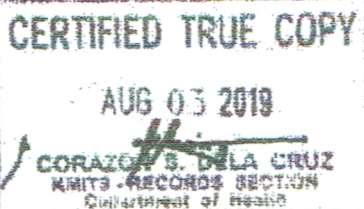
- Search and destroy activity in the school premises, offices, and communities with officials from DOH, DepEd, DILO, OCD and Local Government Unit
- Visit to a nearby primary health unit to check/showcase its readiness to provide dengue prevention services

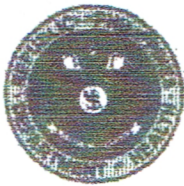
