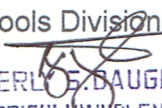

Dear Dr. Batoon:

The Davao Association of Catholic Schools, Inc. in partnership with the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) will host the **Coaching Certification Training** for teachers and other coaching professionals from **September 25-29, 2019**. The venues will be at the DACS Training Center, Juna Subd., Davao City and the Sports Complex in Bago Oshiro. The training comes with **15 CPD Units**.

The PSC will bring in sports training experts as resource persons from leading universities in the country and will subsidize lunch, snacks, training materials for 5 days. However, DACS will charge a minimal fee of PHP 200 for the CPD program. The participants will be the ones to arrange for their accommodation and transportation. Please see attached program description, list of resource persons and contact numbers of lodging houses in Davao City.

The certification program will include only the following events, namely, **table tennis, futsal/football, Philippine rugby, track and field and swimming**. The training will cover topics as sports philosophy, ethics, nutrition, pedagogy and psychology in sports conditioning. There will be concurrent workshops for the different sports events.

May we request for your kind endorsement and invitation for public schools' coaches and MAPEH teachers in the Division of Davao City. Interested participants may fill-out the attached reply form and send to DACS as soon as possible as reservation will be on a first-come-first-served basis. **Walk-in registrants will be given second priority as we are limiting slots to one hundred-fifty (150) only.**

Program Title: Philippine Sports Commission Coaches Education and Training Program

Program Implementer: PSC Davao Cluster in cooperation with the Davao Association of Catholic Schools, Inc.,

Program Background:

The Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) is the government mandated agency to lead in planning, implementing and coordinating a national grassroots sports program where Coaches Education and Training is a needed support for the realization of the National Grassroots Sports Development Program.

The pilot testing of the PSC Coaches Education and Training Modules towards certification shall be done in the Davao City with participant coaches from Department of Education Region XI and some participants coming from Private school system.

Program Needs and Concerns Addressed by the Coaches Education and Training

1. Teachers involved in coaching student athletes are not trained or educated in the science of sports. Most of the coaching techniques or methods employed by coaches are not based on theoretical foundations.
2. Department of Education administrators and teachers themselves expressed the need for coaches education and training of current teachers dealing with athletes.
3. Athletes having the potentials are not able to optimize athletic talents due to poor coaching services. Worse, some athletes experienced injuries due to poor coaching methodology.

Program Description

The long-term plan of PSC is to professionalize the practice of sports in the country. It is in the same line of thought that the Coaching Certification Program is launched targeting coaches in the public and private schools. Coaches shall be categorized into three levels. Coach 1 will have the knowledge and skills of one who knows how to play the game; Coach 2 will have the knowledge and skills on how to train for the game; Coach 3 is one who have the knowledge and skills on how to train trainers for the game.

The Coaching Certification Level 1 consists of two components: Academic or Theoretical Lectures in 6 sports science subjects; and Actual Coaching Clinic in 5 chosen Sports. The academic lectures will last for 1.5 days while the coaching clinic will last for 3 days. Half day is allocated for the examinations for the 6 academic sports science subject and coaching clinic component. In both areas, participant needs to have a passing score in order to receive a Level Coach Certificate. Failure in any areas can be retaken in some other trainings in the future.

Faculty for the Sports Science subjects have their master's degree while coach faculty are certified national coaches in their sports. Those who are certified coaches of PSC will have a permanent ID and serial number controlled by PSC.

Program Goals

1. At the end of the 5-day training program, 150 participants of the Level 1 Coaching Certification will be able to learn the concepts taught in the following 6 subjects: Sports Psychology, Sports Nutrition, Sports Medicine, Sports Philosophy, Sports Ethics, and Sports Physiology.
2. 150 participants shall be able to pass the practical and written examinations for the Level 1 Coaching Clinic Certification.

Target Beneficiaries:

The Level 1 Coaching Certification Pilot Test program shall cater to 150 coaches from the Private and Public schools.

Partner Agencies:

Davao Association of Catholic Schools, Inc

Methods of Implementation

The training module shall be delivered in lecture, film viewing, practice demonstration, and written examinations.

Venue of the Program

DACS Training Center (Davao City) and Davao Sports Complex, Bago Oshiro

Time line

The program shall be implemented on **September 10-14, 2019**

Project Monitoring and Evaluation

Rapid assessment of the program including video documentation shall be done. The work shall be assigned to a research office of a partner university.
