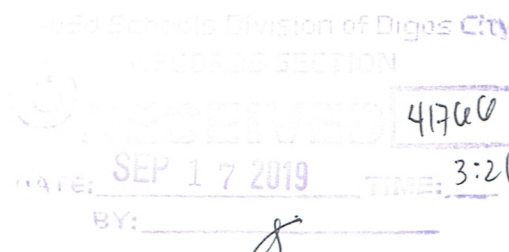

Pre-registration deadline will be on or before October 7, 2019 . Clearly, NO WALK-INS ARE ALLOWED .	

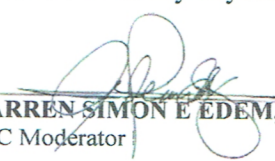

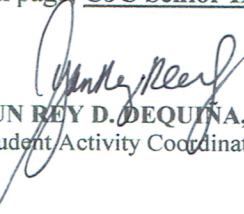

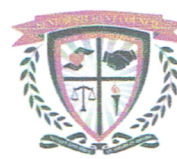
