The most dreaded African Swine Fever is now wrecking disaster to the pig industry of the country. The big problem is that no medicines had been discovered or found for its cure.

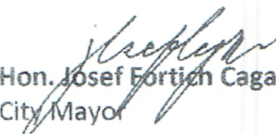
