**DISSEMINATION ON REGIONAL MEMORANDUM 031, S. 2020 REQUIRING
PRIVATE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS IN BASIC EDUCATION WITH
RECOGNIZED STATUS TO SUBMIT THEIR LEARNING CONTINUITY
PLAN, HEALTH PROTOCOLS AND SCHOOL CALENDAR FOR
SY 2020-2021 IN THE FACE OF COVID 19 PANDEMIC**

To: School Heads of Private Elementary and Secondary Schools with Recognition Status
All Others Concerned

1. In pursuance to Regional Memorandum No. 031, s. 2020 dated June 16, 2020, and in view of the national emergency brought about by the COVID 19 pandemic and its effects to education, this office hereby disseminates that the DepEd Regional Office XI requires all private educational institutions in basic education **with recognition status** to submit to this schools division office for review, evaluation and monitoring purposes the following:
 - a. their **School's Learning Continuity Plan** showing alternative delivery modes of learning when face-to-face learning is not allowed, which shall constitute compliance with the requirement provided under Item 6 of Annex 3, DepEd Order 021, s. 2019;
 - b. their **school's plan for compliance with minimum health standards** issued by DepEd, consistent with the guidelines of the DOH, the IATF and the Office of the President; and
 - c. their schools' **SY 2020-2021 School Calendar**.
2. It is emphasized that submission and subsequent approval of the above-cited documents are considered vital in ensuring that in this time of the pandemic, all educational institutions in basic education are in harmony with the plans, programs, thrusts and directions of the Department of Education and the Philippine Government specifically in the vital effort to ensure the health and safety of all learners, teachers and the school community.
3. Above-cited documents are to be submitted first by the private educational institutions with recognized status to this office for review, evaluation and monitoring purposes, three (3) weeks before their opening of classes or earlier.
4. It is the duty of this office to ascertain whether submitted documents are in consonance with existing policies and guidelines of the DepEd, the DOH, the IATF, and the Office of the President.

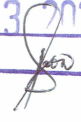

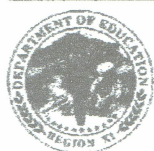
**REQUIRING PRIVATE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS IN BASIC EDUCATION
WITH RECOGNIZED STATUS TO SUBMIT THEIR LEARNING CONTINUITY
PLAN, HEALTH PROTOCOLS AND SCHOOL CALENDAR FOR
SY 2020-2021 IN THE FACE OF COVID 19 PANDEMIC**

To : Schools Division Superintendents
School Heads of Private Elementary and Secondary Schools with
Recognition Status
All Others Concerned

1. In view of the national health emergency brought about by the COVID 19 pandemic and its effects to education, this Regional Office requires all private educational institutions in basic education **with recognition status** to submit to their respective Schools-Division Offices (SDOs) for review, evaluation and monitoring purposes the following:

- a. their **School's Learning Continuity Plan** showing alternative delivery modes of learning when face-to-face learning is not allowed, which shall constitute compliance with the requirement provided under Item 6 of Annex 3, DepEd Order 021, s. 2019;
- b. their **school's plan for compliance with minimum health standards** issued by DepEd, consistent with the guidelines of the DOH, the IATF and the Office of the President; and
- c. their school's **SY 2020-2021 School Calendar**.

2. It is emphasized that submission and subsequent approval of the above-cited documents are considered vital in ensuring that in this time of the pandemic, all educational institutions in basic education are in harmony with the plans, programs, thrusts and directions of the Department of Education and the Philippine Government specifically in the vital effort to ensure the health and safety of all learners, teachers and the school community.

3. Above-cited documents are to be submitted first by the private educational institutions with recognized status to the concerned Schools-Division Offices (SDOs) for review, evaluation and monitoring purposes, three (3) weeks before their opening of classes or earlier.
4. SDOs shall ascertain whether submitted documents are in consonance with existing policies and guidelines of the DepEd, the DOH, the IATF and the Office of the President (OP).
5. Concerned SDO through the Schools Division Superintendent shall indorse said documents to the Office of the Regional Director along with a narrative report detailing findings and recommendations two (2) weeks before the opening of classes of the concerned private school for the subsequent issuance of permit to offer by the Regional Director.
