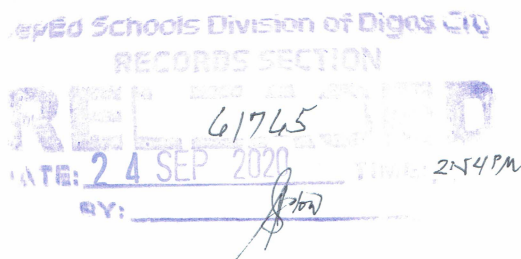

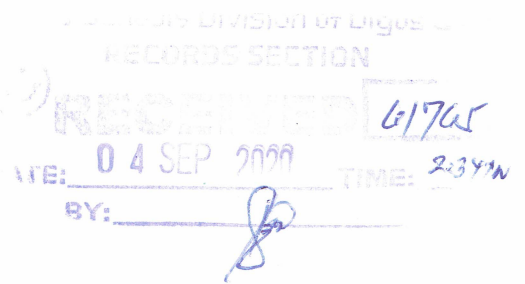

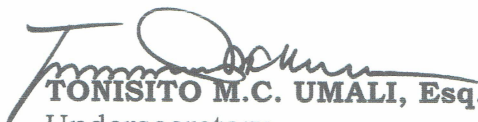

The External Partnerships Service (EPS) has recently concluded the conduct of the *Brigada Eskwela* Partnership Webinar Series #2: **Parents and Teachers in a Home-based Learning Setting** with the theme “*Brigada Eskwela: Bayanihan sa Pag-aaral ng mga Bata*” participated by Visayas Regions (Regions VI, VII and VIII). The webinar oriented and capacitated the parents and teachers with different strategies to serve the learners with the same quality of education while at home.

The objectives of said webinar are as follows:

1. Discuss the general concept of various Distance Learning Modalities;

2. Teach the parents how to act as tutor to replicate the instruction processes in school including a set curriculum, traditional instruction, assignments and others;
3. Identify and appreciate the new role of parents and teachers in distance learning or home-based learning;
4. Create a happy, safe and protective home-based learning environment; and
5. Create individual learning approaches, applicable activities address the individual learners' needs, interests, and goals of learners.

In this regard, the same webinar shall also be conducted in the National Capital Region, Luzon Regions and Mindanao Regions. Attached for your perusal is a copy of the program design. The schedule of the webinar per batch is detailed below:

Further, RFPFs and DPFPs are expected to (1) host a "Watch Party" of the webinar on their official regional FB Page, and (2) coordinate with their local TV and radio stations to broadcast the webinar to further reach targeted participants.

Mass gatherings to assist participants in watching the webinar **may be considered** as long as the health and safety protocols are observed as articulated in the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines with amendments as of June 03, 2020 (*see attached Annex A*) which are as follows:

- (1) **Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ):** Mass gatherings such as but not limited to, movie screenings, concerts, sporting events, and other entertainment activities, community assemblies, and non-essential work gatherings shall be prohibited. However, gatherings that are essential for the provision of government services or authorized humanitarian activities shall be allowed.
- (2) **Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ):** Mass gatherings such as but not limited to, movie screenings, concerts, sporting events, and other entertainment activities, community assemblies, and non-essential work gatherings shall be prohibited. Gatherings that are for the provision of critical government services and authorized humanitarian activities while adhering to the prescribed minimum health standards shall be allowed. Religious gatherings shall be limited to not more than five (5) persons, until otherwise modified through subsequent issuances of the IATF.
- (3) **General Community Quarantine (GCQ):** Mass gatherings such as but not limited to, movie screenings, concerts, sporting events, and other entertainment activities, community assemblies, and non-essential work gatherings shall be prohibited. Gatherings that are for the provision of critical government services and authorized humanitarian activities while adhering to the prescribed minimum health standards shall be allowed. Religious gatherings shall be limited to not more than ten (10) persons until otherwise modified through subsequent issuances of the IATF. Face-to-face or in-person classes at all levels shall be suspended.
- (4) **Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ):** Mass gatherings such as but not limited to, movie screenings, concerts, sporting events, and other entertainment activities, religious services, and work conferences shall be allowed provided that participants shall be limited to fifty percent (50%) of the seating or venue capacity. (As amended by Paragraph A(4)(d) of IATF Resolution No. 43, June 03, 2020).

Relevant expenses incurred in this activity shall be charged against BPLP Current Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
