**IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DAVAO DEL SUR COVID-19 CONTACT
TRACING SYSTEM (CCTS)**

1. In reference to Provincial Resolution No. 20-405, s. 2020 entitled "A Resolution Enacting Ordinance No. 60, s. of 2020, An Ordinance Implementing the COVID-19 Contact Tracing System in the Province of Davao del Sur and Providing Guidelines Therefore", this Office informs the field that the Schools Division Office (SDO) personnel, teaching, teaching-related and non-teaching personnel will use the **Davao del Sur COVID-19 Contact Tracing System (CCTS)** starting November 11, 2020.

2. All Schools Division Office personnel, school heads, teaching, teaching-related, non-teaching personnel and visitors are required to present the Davao del Sur CCTS card to the security personnel or to the nurse-on-duty for scanning upon entering the Schools Division Office. No one is exempted. Schools are also required to use the Davao del Sur Contact Tracing System. The purpose of the said CCTS is to contain and avert the spread and transmission of the virus through quick the immediate contact tracing of people who may have been possibly exposed to positive COVID-19 confirmed patients within the province.

3. Meanwhile, the Schools Division Office terminates the use of StaySafe.ph effective November 11, 2020.

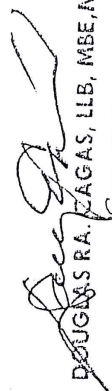
A RESOLUTION ENACTING ORDINANCE NO. 60,s. OF 2020, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING THE COVID-19 CONTACT TRACING SYSTEM IN THE PROVINCE OF DAVAO DEL SUR AND PROVIDING GUIDELINES THEREFORE"

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 15 of the 1987 Constitution expressly declares, that it is the policy of the State to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued Proclamation No. 922, Declaring a State of Public Health Emergency and Proclamation No. 929, declaring the State of Calamity throughout the country by reason of the spread of Corona Virus Disease or COVID-19 which has been declared by the World Health Organization as pandemic;

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic has greatly affected the lives and the economy of the people in the Province of Davao del Sur in particular and the whole Filipino nation in general, hence, the urgent need to mitigate, if not contain, the transmission of the same;

WHEREAS, Republic Act (R.A) No. 11469 or the Bayanihan to Heal as One Act was enacted declaring the existence of national emergency arising from the COVID-19 situation and mandating all government agencies and local government units among others, to fully cooperate and to have a unified and cohesive response to the pandemic, to contain the spread of the virus;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted those necessarily implied therefrom as well as powers necessary appropriate or incidental for its efficient and effective governance and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare such as ensure and support among other things the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public moral, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Davao del Sur (PGDDS) has devised a local contact tracing system called, the Davao del Sur COVID-19 Contact Tracing System (DDS-CCTS), which aims to contain and avert the spread and transmission of the virus through the quick and immediate contact tracing of people who may have been possibly exposed to positive COVID-19 confirmed patients within the province;

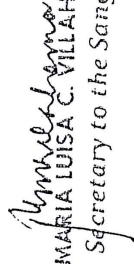
WHEREAS, to achieve an effective and efficient implementation of the contact tracing system, the same requires the compliance of all concerned local government units private and business sectors and the constituents of the province specifically in the conduct of the data gathering and processing of basic personal information as well as the ultimate use and the implementation of the system within the territorial jurisdiction of the province.

WHEREAS, Section 6 (e) (3) of R.A. No, 11332 mandates the conduct of epidemic/outbreak and epidemiologic investigations, case investigations, patient interviews, review of medical records, contact tracing storage, transport and testing of specimen, risk assessments, laboratory investigations, population surveys and environmental investigations;

WHEREAS, Section 12 R.A. No 10173, otherwise known as the Data Privacy Act of 2012, provides the criteria for the lawful processing of personal information in times of national emergency to protect life and ensure public health and order, which states, among others that (1) "the processing is necessary to protect vitally important interests of the data subject including life and health", and (2) "the processing is necessary in order to respond to national emergency, to comply with requirements of public order and safety, or to fulfill functions of public authority which necessarily includes the processing of personal data for the fulfillment of its mandate as provided in Sections 12 (d) and (e) thereof, respectively;

WHEREFORE, on motion of the Honorable Arvin B. Malaza, unanimously seconded, it was;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to enact the following ordinance.

ORDINANCE NO. 20-60

AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING THE DAVAO DEL SUR COVID-19 CONTACT TRACING SYSTEM AND PROVIDING GUIDELINES THEREFORE

Be it ordained by the 16th Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Davao del Sur in regular session assembled that:

Section 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known as the “**DAVAO DEL SUR COVID-19 Contact Tracing System Ordinance or DDS-CCTS**”.

Section 2. PURPOSE. This ordinance aims to contain and avert the spread and transmission of the virus through the quick immediate contact tracing of people who may have been possibly exposed to positive COVID-19 confirmed patients within the province.

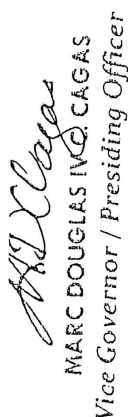
SECTION 3. STATEMENT OF POLICY. It is the policy of the Provincial Government of Davao del Sur (PGDDS) to protect its residents and visitors within its territorial jurisdiction against COVID-19 through an effective and efficient implementation of the contact tracing system which requires compliance of all concerned local government units (LGUs), private and business sectors, residents and visitors of the province.

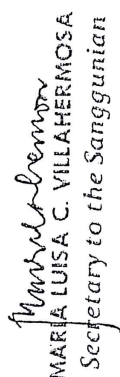
SECTION 4. SCOPE AND COVERAGE. This ordinance shall cover all business establishments, government offices, places of worship, residents, and visitors within the territorial jurisdiction of the Province of Davao del Sur (PGDDS) to include public utilities and spaces, such as but not limited to, public markets, public terminals and public transport.

SECTION 5. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For the purpose of this ordinance, the following terms are defined as follows:

- (a) “**DDS-CCTS Card**” refers to a card issued by the Provincial Government of Davao del Sur to a resident within the territorial jurisdiction of the Province that will serve as a digital logbook when entering the premises of the government offices or private establishments for the purpose of recording the date and time of entry or visit and which bears the holder’s name, address, identification number and a uniquely-assigned QR code;
- (b) “**CCTS Visitor’s Card**” refers to a card issued by the Provincial Government of Davao del Sur to visitors of the province who may have temporary personal or business transaction within the province or who report to work on a daily basis in the province but reside outside the province.
- (c) “**Close Contact**” refers to a person who may have come into contact with a probable or confirmed case two days prior to onset of illness of the confirmed COVID-19 case until the time that said case tests negative on laboratory confirmation or other approved laboratory test through:
 - 1. Face-to-face contact with a probable or confirmed case within one (1) meter and for more than fifteen (15) minutes;
 - 2. Direct physical contact with a probable or confirmed case;
 - 3. Direct care for a patient with probable or confirmed COVID-19 disease without using proper personal protective equipment;

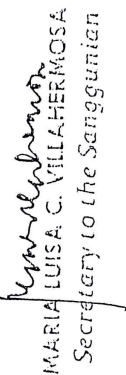

4. Staying in a same close environment of a COVID-19 patients (including workplace, classroom, household, gathering) within the past 14-days period;
5. Traveling together in close proximity (1 meter or less) with a COVID-19 patient in any kind of conveyance within a 14-day period after the onset symptoms in the case under consideration.

(d) "Confirmed" refers to any individuals irrespective of presence or absence of clinical signs and symptoms who was laboratory-confirmed COVID-19 in a test conducted at the national reference laboratory a subnational reference laboratory and/or DOH-certified laboratory testing facility.

(e) "Contact Tracing" refers to the identification listing and follow-up of persons who may have come into close contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case. Contact tracing is an important component in containing outbreaks of infectious diseases.

(f) "Contact Tracing Team" is an LGU identified team that shall conduct case investigation and collect data fields of the COVID-19 Case using Case Investigation Form and Travel History Form or any information technology system and shall rigorously locate, profile and assess all close contacts. The Local Contact Tracing Teams (CCTs) shall identify symptomatic close contacts who fit the COVID-19 case definition based on Administrative Order 2020-0013, test and isolate them using the same guidelines.

The respective local CCTs in each LGU shall be led by the Philippine National Police (PNP) Chief of Police and assisted by the City/Municipal Health Office (C/MHO) with the following members: Staff from the PNP, City/Municipality Police Station, City/Municipality Health Office and Bureau of Fire Protection, the City/Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction Management Officer, the City/Municipality/Barangay Health Worker, the Barangay Health Emergency Response Team (BHERT) Members and the Barangay Public Safety Officer pursuant to items 3,2,1 of Memorandum Circular No. 2020-073 of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG).

(g) "COVID-19" is an infectious disease by a newly discovered coronavirus called SARS CoV-2 wherein most people infected with the virus will experience mild to moderate respiratory illness and recover without requiring special treatment.

(h) "Government Office" refers to any Office created by the Constitution or a legislative act having a definite tenure and involving the power to carry out some government functions operating within the territorial jurisdiction of the Province of Davao del Sur.

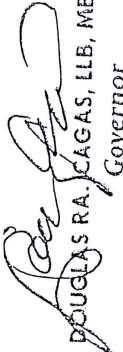
(i) "MESU/CESU" refers to the municipal Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit and then City Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit.

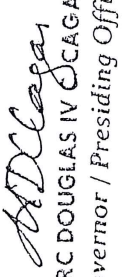
(j) "PESU" refers to the Provincial Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit.

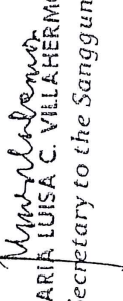
(k) "Private/Business Establishment" refers to any building, structure, or portion thereof that is owned, leased, controlled or operated by a non-government entity for a non-governmental purpose operating within the territorial jurisdiction of the Provincial Government of Davao del Sur.

(l) "Probable" refers to a suspected case under the following circumstances

1. One whom testing for COVID-19 is inclusive.
2. One who tested positive for COVID-19 but whose test was not conducted in a national or subnational reference laboratory or officially accredited laboratory for COVID-19 confirmatory testing; and
3. One who died without undergoing any confirmatory testing.


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- (m) "Quick Response (QR) Code" refers to the trademark for a type of matrix barcode which is a machine-readable code consisting of an array of black and white squares typically used for storing Uniform Resource Locators (URLs) or other information for reading by the camera on a smartphone.
- (n) "Resident" refers to a person living within the territorial jurisdiction of the Province of Davao del Sur.
- (o) "RESU" refers to the Regional Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit.
- (p) RT-PCR" refers to a real-time Reverse Transcriptase-Polymerase Chain Reaction.
- (q) "Davao del Sur COVID-19 Contact Tracing System (DDS-CCTS)" refers to the localized web and mobile-based application developed for the efficient and expeditious contact tracing of confirmed COVID-19 positive patients.
- (r) "Suspect" refers to a person who manifests any of the conditions below.
1. All Severe Acute Respiratory Infection (SARI) Case where NO other etiology fully explains the clinical presentation.
 2. Influenza-like illness (ILI) with either of the following conditions:
 - i. With no other etiology that fully explains the clinical presentation and a history of travel to or residence in an area that reported local transmission of COVID-19 disease during the 14 days prior to symptom onset or;
 - ii. With contact to a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19 in two days prior to onset of illness of the probable/confirmed COVID-19 case until the time the probable/confirmed COVID-19 case became negative on repeat testing.
 3. Individuals with fever or cough or shortness of breath or other respiratory signs or symptoms falling under any one of the following criteria:
 - i. Aged 60 years and above
 - ii. With a comorbidity
 - iii. Assessed as having a high-risk pregnancy
 - iv. Health worker
- (s) "Visitors" refer to persons who are non-residents seeking entry or have already entered the territorial jurisdiction of Davao del Sur and shall include non-residents who are working in the province of Davao del Sur.
- (t) "Logbook" refers to a digital record of important data relative to the contact tracing.
- (u) "Public Utility Vehicle" refers to many forms of transportation that charge set fares, run on fixed routes and are available to the public.
- Examples: Public utility buses (PUB), Public utility jeepneys (PUJ), Public utility van (PUV), Public Utility multicabs and grab vehicles.

SECTION 6. DAVAO DEL SUR – CCTS PROCEDURE. FOR DIGITAL LOGBOOKING

A. **GATHERING AND COLLECTION OF INFORMATION.** For the purpose of gathering baseline information relevant to the conduct of an efficient and speedy close contact tracing, the following provisions shall govern data gathering and collection.

1. The Provincial Government of Davao del Sur, in coordination with its components LGUs shall gather and process relevant information using the Basic Personal Data Form for DDS-CCTS for residents and Visitors provided that Section 12 (a) of R.A. No. 10173 of the Data Privacy Act of 2012 shall be strictly complied with.
2. The following information shall be collected for the purpose of contact tracing:
 - a. Complete Name
 - b. Birthdate
 - c. Address
 - d. Sex, and
 - e. Contact Number
3. All Visitors or non-residents passing through or with temporary business or personal transaction within the province shall be required to register online through the DDS-CCTS and provide the mandatory information for the issuance of QR-coded CCTS Card that they may either print or show for scanning using their mobile phones to the checkpoints and the offices/establishments where they have a transaction.

If the visitors or non-residents have no access to the smartphones or internet, they shall fill out the Basic Personal Data Form for the DDS-CCTS and shall be required to use the pre-printed CCTS Visitors Card with pre-assigned QR Codes Issued by the Provincial Government of Davao del Sur and distributed to all PNP checkpoints. The filled-out form shall thereafter be submitted to the Provincial Government of Davao del Sur for encoding and uploading in the CCTS server.

4. It shall be the responsibility of the Barangay LGUs to assist residents of the province who opt to avail themselves of the DDS-CCTS Card.

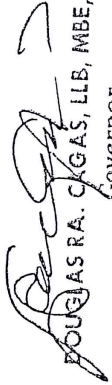
B. **Issuance of CCTS Card.** A system generated CCTS Card shall be issued to the following:

- (1) Residents who registered in the digital logbook of the province, and;
- (2) All visitors of the province.

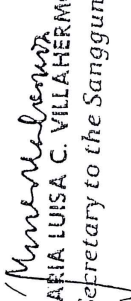
SECTION 7. GUIDELINES FOR GOVERNMENT OFFICES AND PRIVATE ESTABLISHMENTS.

(A) The following shall be required to register in the DDS-CCTS Website:

1. National and local government offices including all government-managed or owned facilities and economic enterprises in the province such as but not limited to: public schools, markets, terminals, hospitals, sports complex and gymnasiums.
2. All private business establishments and entities to include religious and educational institutions; and
3. All models of public transport or public utility vehicles operating in the province.


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Once registered, these establishments shall download the DDS-CCTS mobile application. All CCTS Cards or CCTS Visitor's Card of persons who are entering these registered establishments or offices shall be scanned using the mobile application.

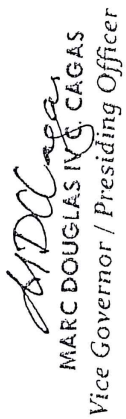
SECTION 8. PROTECTION OF PRIVACY

- (a) The duly designated Data Controller (DC) or Data Protection Officer (DPO) from the PESU shall have authorized access to all information gathered and stored in the server. The DC/DPO shall manage and keep all information with utmost care and confidentiality and shall use the same for contact tracing purposes only. The DC/DPO shall produce the reports necessary to the immediate conduct of contact tracing following the DOH and PESU Protocols.
- (b) The C/MLGUs shall likewise designate their respective DC/DPO from their CESU/MESU for the proper handling of list of close contacts to be provided by the PESU should there be confirmed COVID-19 case.
- (c) All recorded information of a person's date and time of visit or entry in establishments and public utility vehicles shall be automatically deleted from the DDS-CCTS as well in the manual logbook sixty (60) days after their storage thereto.

SECTION 9. STANDARD CONTACT TRACING PROCEDURE. The following procedure shall govern the conduct of contact tracing in the Provincial government of Davao del Sur.

- (a) **Receipt of Result and Generation of Reports for Close Contact.** Upon receipt of the confirmed case result of the person, the DC/DPO and chief of PESU shall immediately generate a report on the list of places where the confirmed person had been, including dates and time of entry in those places. Only the assigned identification number of the confirmed infected person shall appear on the report. The list of all close contacts in these places shall then be generated from the system with their names, address, age, sex and contact number.
- (b) **Dissemination of List of Close Contact and Identification of High-Risk Close Contact.** The list of close contact with necessary information for immediate validation shall be disseminated by the DC/DPO and Chief of PESU to the respective local government units through their duly designated CESU/MESU-DC/DPO for validation and identification of high risk close contact.
- (c) **Logistics Preparation.** The CESU/MESU will submit the validated list of close contacts to PESU for logistics preparation.
- (d) **Dissemination of Validated Close Contacts to Contact Tracing Team and Implementation of Quarantine Protocols.** The list of validated close contacts will be disseminated to the city/municipal contact tracing team and to ensure that they will be quarantined according to the set Department of Health Protocols.
- (e) **Daily Monitoring of Close Contacts.** The CCT shall closely monitor the quarantined close contacts on a daily basis. If symptomatic, the close contacts will be isolated and tested (RT-PCR). Regardless of the result, the CCT shall disseminate the result to the concerned LGU.
- (f) If close contact becomes positive, repeat the procedure from (a) to (e).

- (f) **Enforcement and Monitoring** – Provincial Legal Office, PPDO, Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office and PGO-BAU. This sub-committee shall monitor and ensure compliance of all concerned with this ordinance.

SECTION 11. DAVAO DEL SUR – CCTS AUDIT TEAM. There shall be created a system audit team that shall conduct regular assessment and evaluation of overall system and to ensure data protection and privacy in the entire process or stages of system implementation up to the unit deletion of data. The team shall be composed of external experts and/or local representatives from the academe, civil society organizations, Department of the Interior and Local Government, Commission on Human Rights and Department of Information and Communications Technology.

SECTION 12. PENAL PROVISION. The following acts shall be sanctioned through the imposition of corresponding penalties.

- a) In case of failure of any private establishment and public utility vehicle to register in the DDS-CCTS within 15 days from the effectivity of this ordinance, failure to scan all CCTS Cards of clients/visitors, they shall be sanctioned as follows:

1 st Offense	- Php 1,000.00 fine
2 nd Offense	- Php 2,500.00 fine
3 rd and Succeeding Offenses	- Php 5,000.00 fine or imprisonment not more Than six (6) months or both at the discretion of the court.

In the case of the government office, the Head of Office maybe held administratively liable pursuant to applicable laws.

With respect to the private establishments, the proprietor or owner and for the public utility vehicles, the operator or the registered owner shall be sanctioned.

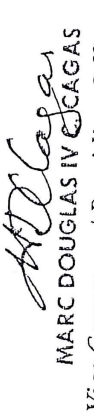
1 st Offense	- Php 1,000.00 fine
2 nd Offense	- Php 2,500.00 fine and Suspension of business permit
3 rd and succeeding Offenses	- Php 5,000.00 fine or revocation of business permit.

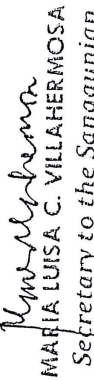
Any person who willfully uses the CCTS Card of another shall be sanctioned as follows:

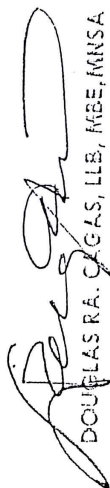
1 st Offense	- Php 1,000.00 fine
2 nd Offense	- Php 2,500.00 fine
3 rd and succeeding Offenses	- Php 5,000.00 fine or imprisonment of not more Than six (6) months or both at the discretion of the court.

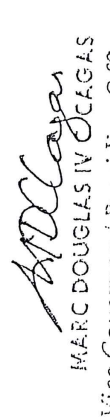
Those who are found violating the provisions of national laws in relation to the implementation of the contact tracing system such as but not limited to the Data Privacy Act (R.A. No. 10173) and the Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Disease and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act (R.A. No. 11332) shall be prosecuted and penalized in accordance with the provisions of the said law.

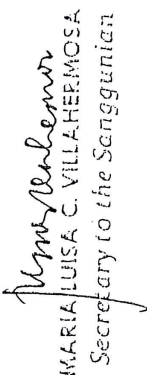
- b.)Unauthorized disclosure of data and information in violation of the ordinance shall be punished under relevant data privacy laws of the Philippines.

SECTION 13. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.

- a) The Sub-committee on enforcement and Monitoring of the DDS-CCTS Implementing Committee shall prepare and submit to the Provincial Governor the implementing Rules and Regulations of this ordinance with 10 calendar days from its enactment:
- b) The Basic Personal Data Form for DDS-CCTS – Residents (Annex “A”) and the Basic Personal Data Form for DDS-CCTS – Visitors (Annex “B”) hereto attached shall form integral parts of this ordinance:
- c) The quarantine passes issued by all component LGUs shall continue to be implemented, independent of the DDS-CCTS Card and CCTS Visitors Card provided in this ordinance. The CCTS Cards shall not replace the aforementioned LGU quarantine passes.
- d) The PGDDS shall ensure compliance with the requirements of relevant national government agencies relative to the development and implementation of the DDS-CCTS Application as the Department of information and Communications Technology and National Privacy Commission:
- e) In support of the National government programs in the fight against the COVID-19 pandemic and pursuant to DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2020-081 all residents of Davao del Sur are enjoined to register to StaySafe.PH to complement the local contact tracing system: and
- f) The implementation of this ordinance shall strictly comply with R.A. No 11332 R.A. No 11469, R.A. No. 10173 and other related laws, rules and issuances.

SECTION 14. APPLICABILITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall apply only during times of COVID-19-related health emergencies as declared by the provincial and/or national government.

SECTION 15. TERMINATION CLAUSE. After the applicability of this ordinance the DDS-CCTS App shall be removed from smartphones and App Stores and all information collected, processed and stored for the purpose of the DDS-CCTS shall be deleted from the server.

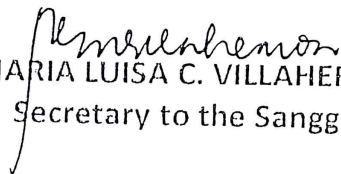
SECTION 16. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any part or provision of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the other parts or provisions hereof.

SECTION 17. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, orders, issuances, rules and regulations, contrary to or inconsistent with provisions of this ordinance are hereby, repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 18. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the same has been posted in conspicuous places, barangay halls and other public places in the province of Davao del Sur and in social media for three consecutive weeks and shall also be published in the newspapers or in general/local circulation and that copies of the same be furnished to all municipalities and city for their information and guidance.
