**WRITESHOP ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF LESSON EXEMPLARS
ON FINANCIAL EDUCATION INTEGRATION (FOR ELEMENTARY LEVELS)**

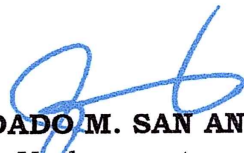

1. **Republic Act No. 10679** entitled “**An Act Promoting Entrepreneurship and Financial Education Among Filipino Youth**” or known as the “**Youth Entrepreneurship Act**” has been declared a basic state policy to promote the sustained development of young Filipinos whose aptitude and skills in the field of finance and entrepreneurship shall be encouraged and honed through education and specialized training programs. Section 4 of the said Act states that the promotion of youth entrepreneurship and financial literacy program shall be inculcated in all levels of education nationwide. Consistent with Section 5 of **Republic Act No. 10533**, or the “**Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013**”, the Department of Education (DepEd) ensures that the K to 12 curriculum shall be supported by programs on entrepreneurship and financial literacy, provided, however, that the program and activities referred to for the elementary level shall be focusing principally on ideal values necessary to become successful entrepreneurs.
2. In 2005, the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) strongly recommended that financial education should be taught as early as possible at the elementary level. Financial education is a long-term process. Building it through the curriculum in the early grades allows children to acquire the knowledge and skills that would help them build responsible financial behavior throughout all stages of their education.
3. In line with this, the Bureau of Learning Delivery - Teaching and Learning Division (BLD-TLD) will conduct an online Writeshop on the Development of Lesson Exemplars on Financial Education Integration (for Elementary Levels) on December 14-23, 2020.
4. The writeshop aims to develop lesson exemplars in Araling Panlipunan (AP), Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP), and Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan (EPP) integrating financial education concepts and competencies from the K to 12 Curriculum.
5. In this connection, we would like to invite one (1) AP, one (1) EsP, and two (2) EPP teachers from your regions to participate in this writeshop. Kindly send the list of recommended participants using the attached template (*Annex A*) to Ms. Joselita Gulapa at **joselita.gulapa@deped.gov.ph**. Recommended participants are requested to register at <https://bit.ly/FinEd2020-reg> not later than December 12, 2020 to confirm their participation.

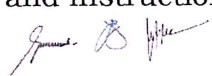
