Logistical Arrangements:

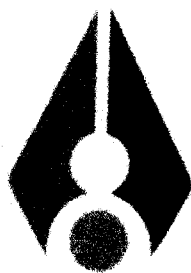
ACERT and TII suggest the following technical arrangements to implement the event:
