6. All EsP School Coordinators are directed to submit a comprehensive report on the relevant activities implemented in their level using the attached template with pictorials through google link which shall be posted in the EsP coordinators' group chat.

Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 101, s. 2022, from the Office of Hon. Epimaco V. Densing III, Undersecretary and Chief of Staff, of the Office of the Undersecretary for Curriculum and Instruction, in compliance with Presidential Proclamation No. 479 s. 1994, which declared November of Every Year as Filipino Values Month, this Office informs that the Department of Education joins the nation in the celebration of the 2022 National Observance of the Filipino Values Month, from November 1-31, 2022, with the Theme: *Magagandang Kaugaliang Pilipino: Isabuhay at Pagyamanin Tungo sa Matiwasa at Maunlad na Kinabukasan.*

This year's celebration focuses on how each Filipino values can be strengthened and practiced to contribute to the realization of individual and national goals to pave the way towards nation-building.

In view of this, all schools, both public and private are encouraged to integrate Filipino values in the teaching and learning activities, in *all learning areas*. Such values may also be integrated into the activities of the different national celebrations within the month.

It is also advised that schools will post a tarpaulin that displays their support for the observance of the FVM, using the ROXI official layout.

The activities relative thereto shall be conducted in accordance with the utmost observance of DO 9, s. 2005; and to the prescribed minimum public health standards set by the Inter-Agency Task Force.

All the SDO Education Supervisors are advised to monitor and provide technical assistance to continuously provide support for the observance of the FVM, and to submit a comprehensive report on the relevant activities implemented at the SDO level, using the attached template, on or before December 2, 2022 at <https://tinyurl.com/2022FVMR>.

2022 NATIONAL OBSERVANCE OF THE FILIPINO VALUES MONTH

1. Presidential Proclamation No. 479 titled **Declaring the Month of November of Every Year as Filipino Values Month** was signed on October 25, 1994, by the late President Fidel V. Ramos to create moral awakening and national consciousness on human values that are unique, genuine, and positively Filipino. With this declaration, Filipinos of all ages and from all sectors of the society are enjoined to actively participate in this annual observance.

2. In compliance with the proclamation and ensure realization of its goal, the Department of Education (DepEd) joins the nation in the celebration of the **2022 National Observance of the Filipino Values Month** with the theme, *Magagandang Kaugaliang Pilipino: Isabuhay at Pagyamanin Tungo sa Matiwasay at Maunlad na Kinabukasan*. This year's theme focuses on how Filipino values can be strengthened and exercised in the life of each Filipino that can contribute to nation-building and achievement of individual and national goals.

3. During the month-long observance, all schools, both public and private are encouraged to integrate the Filipino values in the teaching-learning activities, not only in *Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP)* but also in all the different learning areas. Likewise, such values can also be incorporated in the activities of the different celebrations of the month, such as the:

- a. National Children's Month,
- b. Economic and Financial Literacy Week,
- c. Global Warming and Climate Change Consciousness Week,
- d. *Araw ng Pagbasa*,
- e. National Week for the Gifted and Talented,
- f. National Science and Technology Week, and
- g. Other Co-curricular activities.

4. The DepEd offices, regional, division, district, and school levels in collaboration with other stakeholders may create campaign and advocacy materials anchored on the theme to increase awareness among learners and community people.

5. Activities relative to the observance of the Filipino Values Month (FVM) shall be held in accordance with DepEd Order (DO) No. 9, s. 2005, titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith and DO 034, s. 2022, titled School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2022-2023.

6. During the celebration of the FVM, the minimum public health standards and Inter-Agency Task Force rulings shall be observed to prevent and minimize the spread of COVID-19 in the country.

7. The DepEd through the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD), regional and schools division offices shall continuously support the observance of FVM through monitoring, provision of technical assistance, and feedback of the implementation of activities during the month-long celebration of the FVM to ensure sustainability of promoting Filipino values in the entire basic education system.

8. The regional offices shall submit a comprehensive report that describes the activities implemented in relation to the observance of the FVM following the enclosed template through email at bld.tld@deped.gov.ph not later than **December 31, 2022**. These reports will serve as basis for future policy development.

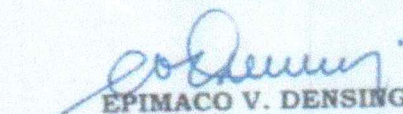
