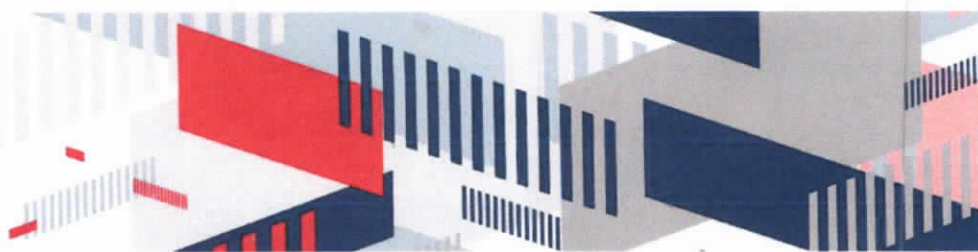

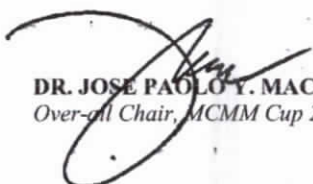

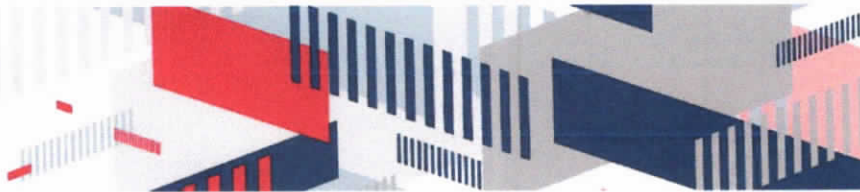

GENERAL GUIDELINES

On Eligibility, Registration and Mechanics

The rules and regulations stipulated herein apply to all the contests and event components of MMCM Cup 2023: Innovation and Beyond except for some provisions that are applicable only to the specific events and contests in this series. A separate detailed mechanics is also provided along with this general set of guidelines.

We strongly encourage all coaches and faculty advisers of the participating schools to carefully read to fully understand the provisions stipulated herein and in the other sections. It is also advised that the same rules be discussed thoroughly to the participating high school students to make all expectations clear.

This Year's Theme: Innovation and Beyond

Last year's "MCM CUP 2022: Breaking Boundaries" was remarkable.

Mapua Malayan Colleges Mindanao has placed the principles of outcomes-based education on its vanguard serving as the threshold of instruction, research, and extension services as evidenced in the annual MMCM Cup series.

3. The School Head/Principal/Director is requested to certify the eligibility and qualification of their student participants.
4. MMCM Cup 2023 competitions are open for **Grade 9 to Grade 12 students**. There are competitions for specific grade level. Please check the specific contest mechanics along with this document.

REGISTRATION

- PRE-REGISTRATION is required for all participating schools.
- Registration forms are provided in this kit. The same can also be accessed and downloaded from the MMCM Website www.mcm.edu.ph or <https://www.mcm.edu.ph>
- Duly accomplished Registration Forms must be submitted to mcmcup@mcm.edu.ph that can be accessed in <https://www.mcm.edu.ph/mcm-cup> on or before **March 15, 2023**.
- The Over-all Steering Committee for the MMCM Cup 2022 reserves the right to refuse acceptance of registration forms after the said date.
- Incomplete data provided in the official registration form is a ground for non-acceptance of the registration submitted and will result to prohibition from participating in any of the event components. Mapua Malayan Colleges Mindanao (MMCM) reserves the right to decide on issues pertinent to the qualification and disqualification of entries and nominated participants.
- Any form of misrepresentation is not allowed in the registration of participating teams, and student-participants. Once proven, this will result to disqualification.
- For pre-recorded events, participating schools must ensure a clear video and audio quality of their entries.
- For on-the-day events, participating schools must ensure a stable Internet connection and provide participants with devices with good video and audio quality.
- Turning on of video cameras is a must for on-the-day events.
- Virtual Room Links of all events will be provided to the participating schools.
- Appropriate attire must be worn by all the participants. Any obscene or derogatory clothing, apparel, and the like shall be dealt accordingly.
- Observe the following while on video conference:
 - Turn on the camera if it is needed
 - Mute the mic. Turn on only when needed.
 - Choose a non-distracting venue
 - It is recommended to use a plain background.
 - Be a responsible user of the tool.
 - Respect the other participants in the virtual room.
- Registration forms may be submitted **through email** then fill out the duly accomplished registration forms and send to mcmcup@mcm.edu.ph

MCM CUP SCORING RUBRICS

- As part of MMCM's commitment to outcomes-based education, the scoring rubrics for the large group events (e.g. MMCM Street Dance Street Dance Battle) will also be outcome-based.
- Finalists of each event component will get corresponding scores which will be totaled with the scores from other events to determine the final school standing. The final standing will determine the **Over-all Champion, First Runner Up** and **Second Runner Up** respectively.
- The table below shows the corresponding scores that can be earned by every finalist of each event:

CONDUCT OF "KNOWLEDGE" EVENTS

- Participants are requested to be at least one (1) hour before the official start of the event.
- Each question will be read twice.
- The timer starts upon the cue of the Quizmaster.
- Each team will be provided with an iPad, an apple pencil and scratch papers to be used for their computations. Each member of the team may bring their own writing material (ballpoint pens and/or pencil).



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25. Final answers should be written on the iPad.
26. Watchers will be assigned to ensure that no alterations are made on the iPad at the end of the designated time.
27. Answers must be written in print (not cursive) and readable.
28. At the end of the time limit, one (1) member of the team should raise the iPad.
29. Wrong spelling answers will not be credited.
30. In case of mathematical answers, answers with wrong unit will not be accepted.
31. Numerical answers in mathematical questions must be specified with the required number of decimal places. Failure to comply will invalidate the answers.
32. Further questions on accuracy of numerical answers will be referred to the Board of Judges.
33. No deductions will be made for wrong answers or questions not answered.
34. One (1) non-programmable calculator will be allowed for each team. Mathematical tables and conditional scratch papers will be provided. No other materials (e.g. reference books, notebooks, etc.) will be allowed during the quiz show.
35. In case of tie, clincher questions will be randomly selected from pool of questions until the tie is broken.
36. In case of complaints, they must be aired and settled first before reading the next question and before declaring the winner. Clarification regarding the questions and answers should be directed to the panel of judges. Only the quizzers in a particular round can raise questions. Otherwise, the decision of the quiz show committee will be final and irrevocable.
37. All questions shall be raised with decorum (good manners). Any act by the participants derogatory to the Committee and to the Board of Judges shall be dealt with the corresponding penalty to be decided and imposed by the committee including but not limited to the possible disqualification from the Quiz Show and suspension in any future quiz shows organized by MMCM.
38. The panel of judges consists of a chairperson and two members. The judges are disinterested party to any of the participants.
39. Other provisions including policies on Raising Clarifications and Objections on the mechanics, or the conduct of the contests; and other relevant policies are stated in the **General Guidelines on Registration, Eligibility, and other Information** in a separate document. All contestants, coaches and advisers are required to read to fully understand the mechanics of MMCM Cup 2023 events.

PUNCTUALITY AND REGISTRATION REMINDERS

40. Contestants are requested to be in the assembly at least one (1) hour before the event proper to undergo registration procedures and briefing.
41. Each student representative must present their **school ID** on the day of the event that they will be participating in.
42. The order of performances (in the case of large group events) will be pre-determined through electronic draw by the committee. The participants/performers will be informed of the sequence before the start of the event.

ADJUDICATION AND THE PANEL OF JUDGES

43. Questions, clarifications, and objections on the answers submitted during the "Knowledge" events can only be raised by the participants immediately before the next question is given. The Quiz Show Host must acknowledge the point of information by the contestant/s who will then be required to present documentary evidence to support such claim.
44. The Quiz Show Host will then direct the query to the Panel of Judges for adjudication.
45. For large group events (e.g. MMCM Street Dance Battle) the officially appointed coach or faculty adviser may represent the team in seeking for adjudication.
46. **The decision of the Panel of Judges is final.**
47. The Over-all Steering Committee of the MCM Cup 2021 is committed to select members of the panel of judges who are experts in that specific area/field; with proven independence and are objective assessors of outcomes.
48. Members of the panel of judges are ensured to have no connection or affiliation with any of the participating schools.
49. The Over-all Steering Committee of MMCM Cup 2023 through the Panel of Adjudicators of specific events has the sole right to clarify the details in the mechanics.
50. Changes in the rules may be adopted as decided upon by the panel of judges, after a consultation and concurrence with/by the coaches/faculty adviser of the teams, and subject to the approval of the Over-all Chair of MMCM Cup 2023.

51. The true spirit of sportsmanship is greatly encouraged among the competing teams.
52. Coaches and student representatives are expected to behave in a respectful and ethical manner, and observe online etiquette, and any omission may result in the disqualification of a team or ejection of an offender.
53. Coaches and school representatives are reminded not to directly message/chat the members of the panel of judges during the event, unless the reason for such is to request for adjudication. In this case, the coach/ faculty.
54. Adviser should confer with the Event Chair, or the Program Host to be acknowledged and be referred to the Panel of Judges.

AWARDS AND PRIZES

55. The awarding ceremonies will be held on March 31, the last day of MMCM Cup 2023.
56. Winners for all events will receive **cash prize**.
57. Winning schools, on the other hand, shall receive an MMCM Cup 2023 Plaque of Recognition; and the corresponding points to win the MMCM Cup 2023 **Overall Champion, First Runner Up, and Second Runner Up** respectively.
58. The Top Three (3) schools will receive, in addition to the trophies and certificates, the following prizes:

Grand Champion:	PHP 30,000 worth of prizes and Plaque of Recognition
First Runner- Up:	PHP 20,000 worth of prizes and Plaque of Recognition
Second Runner- Up:	PHP 10,000 worth of prizes and Plaque of Recognition

MMCM's POLICY ON ONLINE ETIQUETTE AND PRIVACY OF PARTICIPANTS

59. Upon registration, the participating schools will be more than willing to comply with the policies of the event and are giving the event coordinators the right to impose online policies with the assurance that all participating schools will be dealt with utmost professionalism.
60. Sharing any obscene, defamatory, derogatory images, words, noises, and the like will be dealt accordingly.
61. All links will be sent thru email and must not be shared with non-participating schools or external bodies.

CANCELLATION OF EVENTS and other IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENTS

62. The Overall Steering Committee of the MMCM Cup 2023 is tasked to assess conditions that may affect the conduct of activities. Cancellation, or postponement of activities may be announced due to inclement weather condition, inadvertent declaration of holiday or suspension of classes/ work; or any uncontrolled scenario that might pose danger or threat to the security and safety of the participants.

PARTICIPANTS' ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION

1. Schools may send one (1) participant to join the **MMCM Digital Poster Making Competition**.
2. Participant must be officially enrolled during the term/semester.
3. **PRE-REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED.** Duly accomplished registration forms must be sent to Ms. Vaneza Joy D. Galileo, through mcmcup@mcm.edu.ph on or before March 15, 2023.
4. Incomplete or late registration is a ground for disqualification.
5. Participants must attach their validated school IDs upon registration.

SPECIFIC CONTEST GUIDELINES

1. The digital poster making will be done simultaneously with other participants in one room.
2. Each student is given 2 hours to create a digital poster.
3. The theme will be given prior to the start of the competition.
4. With the use of graphics, vector images, and pictures, they will create a poster in 8.5 x 11 inches canvas; with a resolution of 150 dpi; portrait orientation; and RGB color mode.
5. The participants are allowed to use Adobe Photoshop, InDesign, Illustrator or Corel Draw to create their poster.
6. Students are allowed to source images from the Internet.
7. The submission will be done through the designated OneDrive folder. A 10-minute allowance after the end of the event is provided for the uploading of posters (in PNG or JPEG formats).
8. Failure to upload the required files after the elapsed time has passed will be merit for deduction of points (5 points from the total score).
