In reference to Regional Memorandum No. ESSD-2023-055, entitled, "Management and Supervision of the Gulayan sa Paaralan Program", which informs the field that the management and supervision of the GPP are reverted back to the School Health Division.

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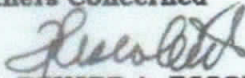

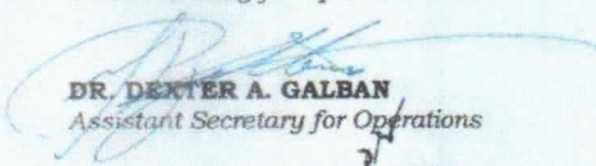
