ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Vision: An empowered Filipino student population who employ globally competitive skills and embodies the ideals of being value-driven, career-oriented, culturally rooted and socially responsible

Mission: Create a pro-active and empowered community of Filipino learners who champion the use and adoption of technology to fellow students in the Philippines.

A. Benefits of the MYA 2.0 Program

- a. **Skill development:** Technology is an ever-evolving field, and Microsoft can help young people develop essential tech skills through workshops, training sessions, and hands-on experiences. This can increase their employability and prepare them for future careers.
