Likewise, for the specialization teachers, they should have at least National Certification (NC II) relative to the sector, e.g., Dressmaking NC II under Garments, Carpentry NC II under Building Construction, etc.

Moreover, it is recommended that the writers who were involved in the revision stage of the Curriculum Guides should also participate in the finalization stage. This will ensure that the writers have a thorough understanding of the changes made during the revision process, and can provide valuable input and feedback during the finalization stage. Additionally, their participation will help to maintain consistency and coherence throughout the development process.
