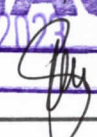

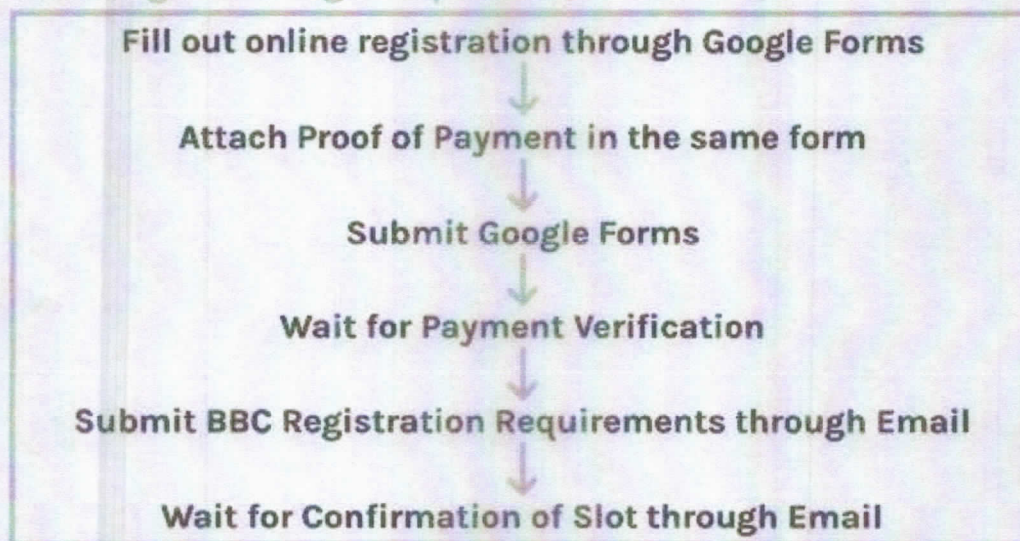

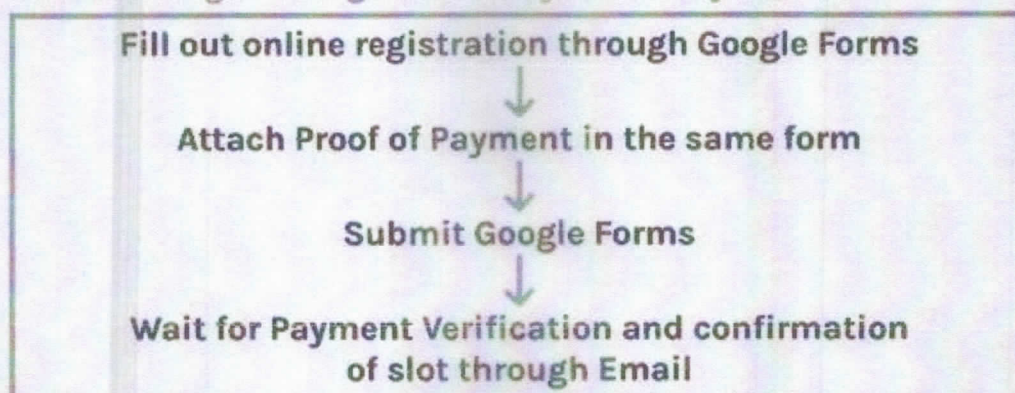


A. GENERAL REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

1. NCES 2023 High School Events is composed of the following:
 - **Bridge Building Competition**
 - **Civil Engineering Laboratory Tour (Day 2)**
2. **All participants must be a current high school student** (Grades 7 to 12) in the Philippines, regardless of strand.
3. Type of Registration:
 - **Bridge Building Competition** will follow **team registrations**. A representative of the team shall fill out the registration form and will be considered as the **Team Representative**.
 - **Civil Engineering Laboratory Tour (Day 2)** will accommodate **individual or group registrations**. For the latter, the representative of the group shall fill out the registration form and will be considered as the **Group Representative**.
4. Only the following will be accommodated:
 - The first **60 teams** for the Bridge Building Competition
 - The first **140 participants** for Civil Engineering Laboratory Tour (Day 2)
5. If there are available slots on the day of the event, walk-in teams will be allowed to participate. For **walk-in guidelines**, refer to **Section C.I.8**.
6. All participants of the Bridge Building Competition and Civil Engineering Laboratory Tour (Day 2) are required to attend the High School Career Talk and Company Talk.
7. General procedure to follow:
 - For **Bridge Building Competition**,



- For Civil Engineering Laboratory Tour (Day 2),



I. LIMIT TO NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS

1. For Bridge Building Competition,
 - a. A maximum of **two (2) teams per school** are allowed to join the competition.
 - b. Each team shall consist of:
 - i. Three (3) members or participants
 - ii. One (1) faculty member from the school
 - c. For **teams from the same school**, they shall only be accompanied by **one (1) faculty member**.
4. For Civil Engineering Laboratory Tour (Day 2),
 - a. There will be **NO maximum** participants per school.
 - b. Participants may only be accompanied by **one (1) faculty member** from the school.
3. For schools registering in **both events**, Bridge Building Competition and Civil Engineering Laboratory Tour (Day 2), **only one (1) faculty member from the school** may accompany the participants.
4. Individuals, Groups or teams who will be given slots shall be informed through their **Team or Group Representative** via email. Kindly acknowledge this email to verify that you have received the confirmation email.

B. REGISTRATION DATES

Early Bird Registration

July 8, 2023, Saturday (12:00 pm) to July 14, 2023, Friday (11:59 pm)

Regular Registration

July 15, 2023, Saturday (12:00 pm) to August 22, 2023, Tuesday (11:59 pm)

The registration guidelines will strictly be implemented. Participants who wish to register during the Early Registration Period but were **not able to comply** with the requirements **on or before July 14, 2023, (Friday, 11:59 PM)** will be accommodated during the **Regular Registration Period**.

Furthermore, participants who **failed to comply** with the registration requirements during the Regular Registration Period **on or before August 25, 2023, (Friday, 11:59 PM)** will result to **forfeiture of registration slots**.

4. Uploading of Proof of Payment

Attach your receipt or any proof of payment (e.g. deposit slip or screenshot of transaction with transaction number) for the chosen event package in its required field in the same Google Form.

- Kindly ensure that the proof that you will send is CLEAR and READABLE.
 - i. For GCash to GCash transactions, kindly save and attach the receipt provided in the GCash app once the payment has been made.
 - 1. Note: For cashing-in at retail stores, kindly make your own account as the recipient then use the GCash app to send your payment for the registration fee.
 - ii. For interbank transactions (i.e. bank to GCash; other e-wallet to GCash, e-wallet to bank), kindly include the source account number (BANK ACCOUNT OR E-WALLET NUMBER USED) and the date and time of transaction. Please do not cover the parts of the account number. Rest assured that this confidential information will only be used for verification purposes.

6. Verification of Requirements

You will be instructed to attach the correct requirements to the email within **five (5) working days**, otherwise, your slot and payment will be forfeited.

- The following requirements stated in **Section C.I.5** of the new participant shall be attached to the email.
- The individual, team, or group representative will receive a **confirmation email within three (3) to four (4) working days** once the request has been processed and your submitted requirements have been verified. If the submitted requirement/s is/are invalid, an email regarding the invalid requirement/s will be sent. You will be instructed to attach the correct requirements to the email, otherwise, the request to change roster will be considered **null and void**.
- If the individual, team, or group was able to receive an email confirming the request, the certificate of participation to be given on the day of the event shall reflect the new participant's name.
- If the individual, team, or group is unable to notify us and submit the complete list of requirements of the new participant **by September 12, 2023** and still wishes to change the roster of participants, they may still request a change of transfer until the start of the event proper. However, only a **blank certificate** will be provided to the new participant.

8. Walk-Ins

- **Case 1: There are NO remaining slots after the regular registration period.**
 - i. Once an announcement has been made on the official National Civil Engineering Summit Facebook page that there are **NO MORE SLOTS**, walk-ins will **NO LONGER BE ALLOWED** and will not be entertained on the event day itself.

- **Case 2: There are still remaining slots after the regular registration period.**
 - i. Walk-in registrants **MUST** bring their complete requirements as listed in **Section C.I.5**. Those who arrive with incomplete requirements shall **NOT** be accepted.
 - ii. Upon arrival at the venue, the **Individual/Group/Team Representative** along with team members shall immediately approach the registrations table to process requirements.
 - iii. Registrations for **BBC** and **Day 2 Laboratory tour** will still be on a "first come, first served" basis on the event day itself, and the registrant/s must register from **6:00 AM to 7:00 AM** only for **Civil Engineering Lab Tour (Day 2)** while **6:00 AM to 8:00 AM** only for **Bridge Building Competition**. Please bring an official school ID for each participant and any valid ID for the accompanied faculty member..
 - iv. See **Section C.I.2. Event Packages** for walk-in registration fees.



D. IMPORTANT REMINDERS

I. PROGRAM PROPER

- There will only be **one (1) Registration Venue** for the Bridge Building Competition and Civil Engineering Laboratory Tour (Day 2), which will be at the **UP ICE Construction Materials and Structures Laboratory (CoMSLaB)**. **Civil Engineering Laboratory (Day 2)** registration is from **6:00 AM to 7:00 AM** only while **Bridge Building Competition** registration is from **6:00 AM to 8:00 AM** only.
 - i. Participants of the **Bridge Building Competition** must first register at **UP CoMSLaB** before transferring to **UP National Institute for Science and Mathematics Education Development (NISMED)** for the competition. Please come **early** to avoid late registration.
 - ii. Civil Engineering Laboratory Tour participants will be assigned to their respective tour batch (i.e., Batch 1 or 2) **after registration** on the event day itself.
- For group or team registrations, **only** the respective representatives shall approach the Registration Table to register.
- All attendees must present the following upon registration:
 - i. Confirmation of slot email from **nces.reg@gmail.com** (either digital or printed);
 - ii. Current school IDs/ any valid ID for high school student participants and faculty representatives.
- For the Bridge Building competition, participants and accompanying faculty members will be allowed **inside** the venue. For the Civil Engineering Laboratory Tour (Day 2), only the participants will be allowed to join the tour. Thus, faculty representatives are **advised** to stay in UP NISMED.
- School kits which include IDs, souvenir programs, food stubs, and evaluation form will be distributed upon registration on the day of the event.
- Individuals, Group or Team Representatives may approach the Registrations Table to claim their Certificates at the **END** of the event proper at UP NISMED. See **Section D.II.** for further details on claiming certificates.
- Unclaimed certificates will **NOT** be sent via mail, online transfer, fax, or any other method.

II. POST EVENT

- To claim their certificate, **each participant is required to have completed the Evaluation Forms**, which is included in the school kit to be given upon registration.
- Upon completion of the Online Evaluation Forms, the Individual, Group or Team Representative may approach the Registrations Table to claim the certificates. The staff present will confirm the submission of your own or your group/team's responses before releasing the certificates.
 - If applicable, a Certificate of Participation will be given to the faculty member representative.
 - In case the faculty member is not present during the event, he/she will NOT be given a certificate anymore. The alternate faculty representative of the team, however, will receive a blank certificate.

 - Concerns regarding certificate corrections due to a change of roster will no longer be entertained as these were supposedly addressed prior to the event as stated in **Section C.I.7**.
 - Organizers are entitled to reject requests for reprinting of certificates if errors are caused by, but are not limited to, incorrectly encoded information and failure to request for change in participant roster
