Relative to the commitment of the Department of Education (DepEd) to strengthen inclusive education, provide a positive learning environment, promote learner well-being, and accelerate the delivery of basic education services for all learners, including those who are disadvantaged and are at risk of dropping out; and of the submitted report of the Mapping on ADM in all Public Elementary and Secondary Schools, from May 17, 2023, to June 5, 2023, this office informs the conduct of the Monitoring and Evaluation of the ADM Program Implementation, by the Curriculum and Learning Management Division thru the Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM) Program.

The activity aims to monitor, evaluate and gather the regional profile of the ADM program implementation and validate the ADM mapping Reports of the SDO, which information shall serve as the springboard to strengthen the implementation of the Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM) Program in the region.

All the Education Program Supervisors (EPS) In-charge of the Eight (8) Core Learning Areas and Special Curricular Education Programs, whose primary task is to monitor, evaluate and manage the delivery and implementation of the articulated curricula, provide technical assistance to the program implementers, and assure that inclusive education is properly implemented, shall serve as the monitors.

The modality of the activity shall be thru PAKIGHINABI, or the participatory and holistic face-to-face interaction among and between the monitors and their target implementers.

All EPS monitors shall use the quality-assured ADM M and E Tools. The quality-assured M and E Tools of the Learning Areas and PAPs may subsequently be used to gather significant and relevant data for the other programs.

The Regional EPS monitors shall submit the results of the monitoring to the EPS In-charge of ADM, on or before 5 days after the last day of the monitoring activity of each SDO, for consolidation and subsequent submission to the office of the CLMD Chief EPS.

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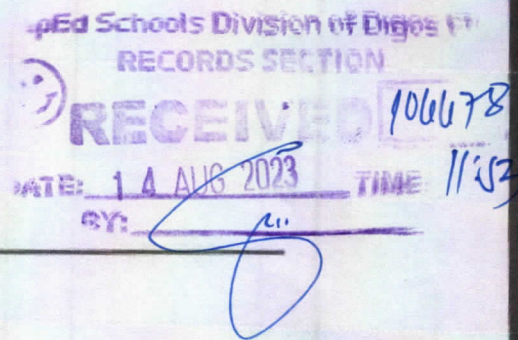
